NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

This information supplements the 2024 Local Rules and Terms of Conditions for the GTA AM Tour. The current issue of the Golf Canada Rules of Golf govern play. **Any rules on the host club scorecard do not apply. Penalty for breach of a Local Rule is the general penalty, unless otherwise noted.**

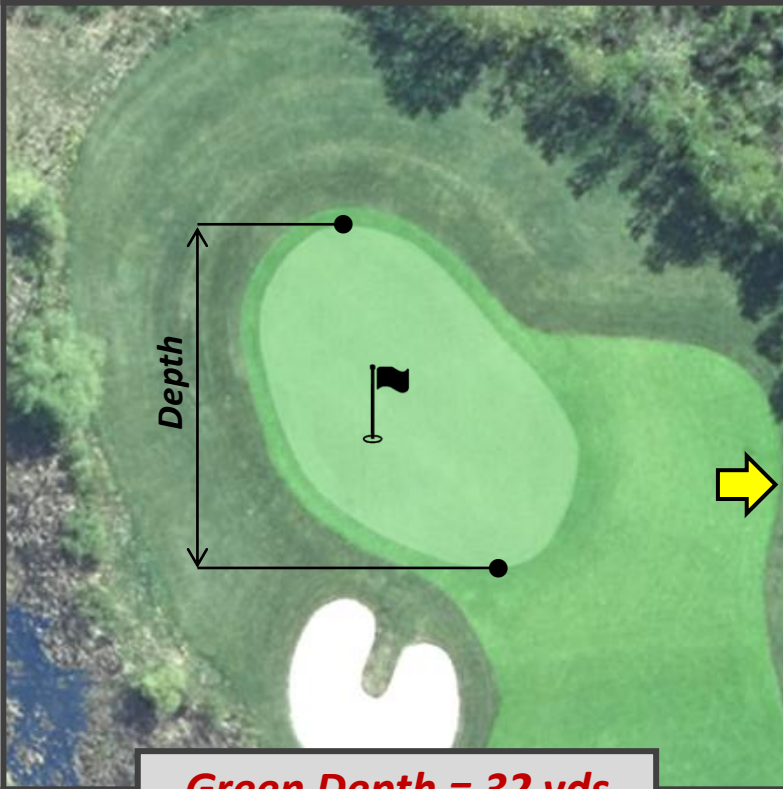
1. **OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 18.2):** See GTA AM Tour Hard Card for how Out of Bounds is defined.
2. **HOST CLUB DROP ZONES ARE NOT AVAILABLE:** Any Drop Zone available at this event will be indicated by a GTA AM Tour sign.
3. **PENALTY AREAS (Rule 17):** Red and yellow lines define the edge of the penalty area. Where penalty areas are not marked with lines, the change in the height of the grass defines the edge of the penalty area. Where there is no change in the height of the grass, the penalty area is defined by its natural boundaries. Unmarked penalty areas are red penalty areas.
4. **OBSTRUCTIONS AND GROUND UNDER REPAIR (Rule 16.1 applies):** Any areas of ground under repair will be marked or noted.

NO PLAY ZONES: Areas that are ornamental garden beds, turf nurseries or decorative flowerbeds are No Play Zones that are to be treated as Ground Under Repair. Players must proceed under Rule 16.1f.

Green Depth = 32 yds

On the left side of the page, you will see the hole number and par. The square image shows the green complex (aligned to the 150-yard marker) with the pin location for the event.

The green depth is also shown. A yellow arrow indicates the direction to the next tee (leave your clubs here when walking).

This box provides pro tips and general information about the hole.

On the right side, the yardages for each flight are shown. The hole image indicates distances from spots in the teeing ground (●●●) to various locations in the landing area (○). The distance text is colour coded to match the teeing ground spots. The actual tee marker positions will vary, but differences can be quickly paced off or estimated. Standard 100 ●, 150 ○, 200 ●, and 250 ● yard markers may also be shown.

Green Depth = 30 yds

Number 1 is a Par 5 dog leg left where the best placed tee shot is left centre of the fairway. A good drive will put you even with the bunkers on the right. Your second shot is a lay-up to about 90-100 yards but avoid the fairway trap on the right. Do not be long, or short side yourself on your approach, or your up and down for Par will be difficult. Short of the green is better than long.

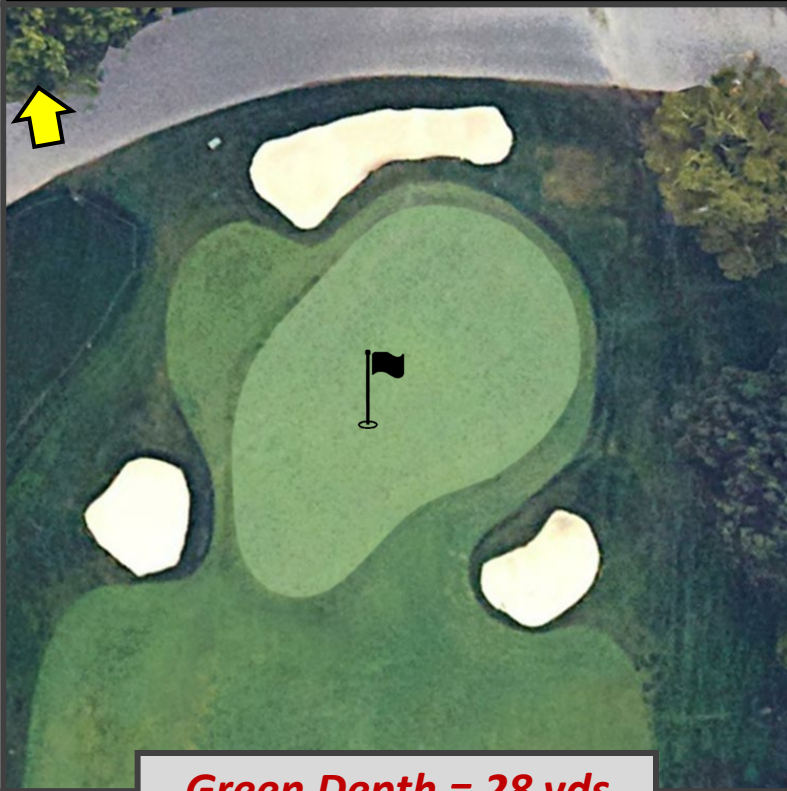

Green Depth = 28 yds

Number 2 is a short Par 4 with many players using a fairway wood off the tee to avoid finding the fairway bunkers. Your approach is to a well guarded green, and be sure to avoid the bunker fronting the green or a long difficult bunker shot awaits. If the pin is on the right, don't be greedy. Playing to the left side of the green gives an opportunity for a 2 putt Par. Long is dead.

Green Depth = 35 yds

Hole 3 is a medium length Par 3 that is pretty much “what you see is what you get.” The only thing to note is the green slopes strongly right to left. If the pin is on the left part of the green, a shot to the middle may roll down to the pin. Don't miss your tee shot left!

Green Depth = 24 yds

The 4th hole is the second Par 5 on the opening 9. This is a three shot Par 5, so straying it a bit off the tee is not too bad. Be careful with your lay-up. Avoid the left fairway bunker and hit it to a comfortable yardage for a wedge approach. The green is small, and not very deep as is well protected. There is a ledge in the middle of the green that will be your friend or enemy!

Green Depth = 37 yds

Number 5 is a very difficult long Par 4. A good tee shot will still leave you a long iron blind approach shot.

Anything off the fairway on your drive will likely force a lay-up. You will not see it on your second shot, but there is a small creek on your right-hand side in the rough about 20 yards back from the green. Don't go right on your approach to the green!



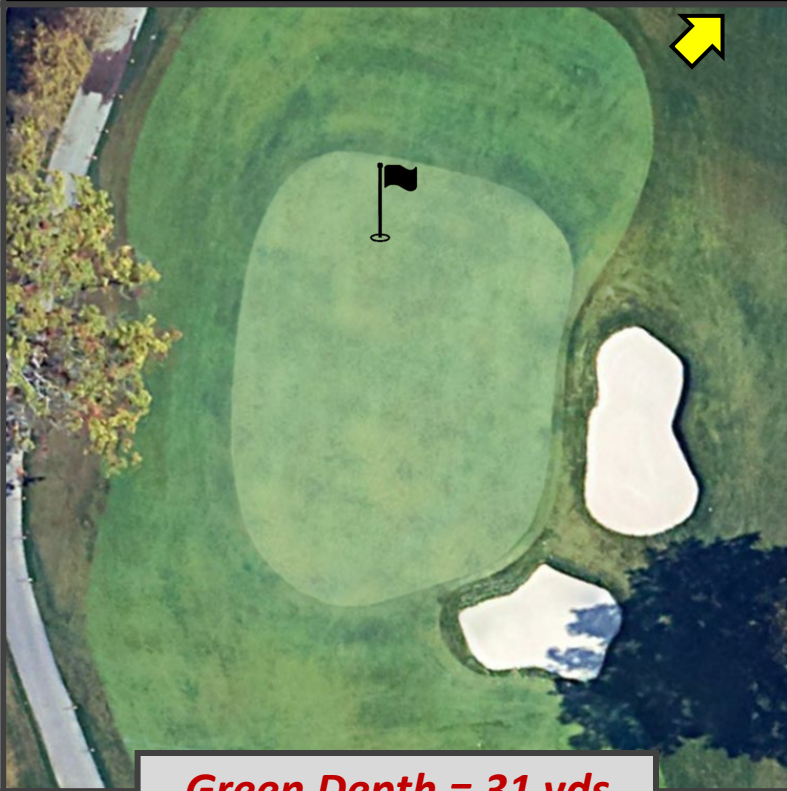

Green Depth = 31 yds

#6 is a great risk/reward Par 4. Your drive is hit out of a chute with water protecting the whole left side of the fairway. You can hit everything from a driver to mid iron, depending on the amount of risk you want to take. The green is sizable but gives good chances for 2 putts from anywhere.

Green Depth = 31 yds

Number 7 is an uphill Par 4. If you are driving it well, you should be able to get it past the road. The only good place to attack the pin is from the middle. If you miss right, you will be blocked by the trees. If you miss left, you may need a low knock down shot to the green. This green is sloped back to front. You want to play below the hole. If you find yourself above the hole, a 2 putt is an excellent result.

Green Depth = 39 yds

#8 is the final Par 3 on the front 9. The only place you don't want to be is short or left. Right or long is not that bad. The green has a lot of break so give it the respect it deserves.

Make sure to crack a

Green Depth = 32 yds

#9 is a seemingly easy Par 4, but leave the driver in the bag. Most players will hit a mid to long iron off the tee to leave the approach shot on the same level as the green. If you are too long from the tee, you will end up in the valley and it will be a difficult shot to the green, which is well above you. On your approach, short and on the green is very good. Left or right will result in a difficult up and down as the green is narrow. Long will be out of bounds.

Green Depth = 40 yds

#10 is a very challenging Par 3 to start the back nine. The wind swirls on this hole, so pick your club wisely, as there is not a lot of room for error anywhere. Short or in the bunkers front left is surprisingly not too bad.

The green is deep and large. Depending where you hit it & where the flag is, a tough 2 putt could be in your future just to secure your Par.

Green Depth = 27 yds

#11 is a beautiful Par 4 down a steep hill with ponds on either side. The fairway bunker does come into play, so be careful. An ideal drive is left-centre of the fairway. Even if you hit the fairway on the right side, you may be blocked out by the big tree, and you will be left with an uncomfortable approach to the green.

Green Depth = 30 yds

#12 is a short Par 5 with a slight dog leg right up a hill to a green well above the fairway. Despite the length, this is often a three shot Par 5. The right bunker comes into play off the tee, so you need to be accurate or stay short of it. Play your second to approximately 100 yards, but keep the ball in the middle of the fairway, as it slopes from right to left. Right of the green is ok, left is trouble.

Green Depth = 30 yds

#13 is a challenging and long Par 4. Position your drive down the right-centre of this fairway. Anything missing left will require a punch out of the trees blocking your approach. The approach is somewhat simple ... except it is very long, even if you bomb it off the tee. Par is a great score here!

Green Depth = 31 yds

Hole #14 is a great, strategic Par 5. Bunkers come into play off the tee, so shorter left or longer right is the best play. If you hit it well, you can give this one a run if the wind is in your back. If not, lay up between the bunkers and leave yourself a full wedge into this green. Anything right is more than likely lost, but anything way left is out of bounds. Keep it between the ropes!

Green Depth = 26 yds

Number 15 is the longest and hardest Par 3 on the course. You will more than likely need a hybrid club to get on this green which has drastic slope in it. Front of the green and right are decent places to miss. The bunker in front of the green to the left will lead to a very difficult up and down.

Green Depth = 33 yds

A great drive on this hole will put you over the road, but will still leave a mid to long iron approach. As you can see from the tee, this hole is straight forward but there is a road and out of bounds all the way down the right side! This is not a hole to get greedy on late in your round.

Make Par and move on!

Green Depth = 36 yds

Depending on your outlook, this is either a fun or intimidating Par 3 playing over water. The wind swirls here, and is usually a club longer than it feels, so pick your club wisely.

Missing the green left or long is Not too bad, so be sure to protect against going in the water.

Green Depth = 30 yds

The 18th is a strategic Par 5 to finish your round. A well-struck drive will get you over the road, but you need to avoid the 2 fairway bunkers.

This is a three-shot Par 5 for all but the longest players, so think about where you want to place your lay-up. The ideal tee shot is down the right-centre, giving you the best view to the green situated along a hillside. The green is narrow, elevated, & well protected, so choosing your approach club is key.

Par is an excellent way to finish!
