GTA AM TOUR COVID-19 RESPONSE PLAN

During the COVID-19 outbreak, the GTA AM TOUR has prepared this document for the purpose of distribution to all players, staff, and host facilities to advocate the measures to be followed from the Provincial Government, Health Officials and Regional Authorities.

All measures to be taken below are specific to our events, taking into consideration what is being recommended from authorities noted above. The GTA AM Tour will follow any/all guidelines put forth by all levels of government and health officials, and also ensure a clear line of communication with each host facility to ensure the safe conduct of everyone while on site at each facility.

GTA AM Tour Team Members (Staff)

The main objective is to ensure the health and safety of everyone during our events. We will require a declaration from each staff member that they are ready, willing, and able to assist in the execution of the event. Each staff member must ensure that they are healthy, and to the best of their abilities, symptom free. If any staff member shares information with the GTA AM Tour that could result in the potential of contact with COVID-19, they will be asked to refrain from participating in the events.

If any staff member discloses any symptoms of COVID-19, they will not be allowed to attend the events, and will be encouraged to seek medical assistance, either through the Ontario Health website or their local physician.

1. Guidelines for GTA AM Tour Staff while at events

- a. The main priority of the tour team members will be to ensure the following:
 - i. Maintain physical distancing (Minimum of 6 feet)
 - ii. Wash hands regularly
 - iii. Disinfect all surfaces

- b. At each event, tour team members will be given the following:
 - i. Mask
 - ii. Gloves
 - iii. Hand Sanitizer
 - iv. Disinfectant Wipes or Cleaner

- c. Once assigned a golf cart, tour team members will thoroughly clean all surfaces before and after use

- d. Items typically given out at each event will now be left with the tour team member for the season. These items will include, but are not limited, to the following:
- i. Clipboard
 1. All items typically printed (Tee Sheet, Time Par Sheet, Etc.) will be e-mailed to each staff member and we will require them to print them off and include for each event
 - ii. Cart Sign
 - iii. Radio & Headset
 - iv. Spotter Flags
 - v. Airhorn

Respect Towards Staff/ Host Facilities/ Competitors

It is tremendously important that all GTA AM Tour staff and competitors respect everyone who is a part of the event as well as respecting the golf clubs for hosting us. As everyone knows, it is an honor to play these amazing golf courses and it is our job as the tour community to respect everyone who is present that day. Following Course guidelines, playing by the rules, and respecting all officials is especially important to the GTA AM Tour and it is something we take great pride in. The GTA AM Tour wants to create a fun yet competitive environment for everyone. For this to happen, all GTA AM Tour staff, officials, competitors, course members, course staff, and the host facility should all be treated with respect, integrity, and kindness.

GTA AM Tour Players

Once the GTA AM Tour has been given permission to conduct events, we will communicate our entire COVID-19 platform, as it relates to our events, with the GTA AM Tour database. Because each host facility could potentially have difference guidance, we will need to take that into consideration and be sure to share all this information with the tour players.

Below is the final draft of communication to the GTA AM Tour database showing what measures we will take to ensure the safety of everyone.

The following safety measures and procedures have been put into place to ensure everyone is safe and healthy this season, while playing on The GTA AM Tour.

ELIGIBILITY / NON-ELIGIBILITY (DURING COVID-19)

Players will be ineligible to play GTA AM TOUR events if they fall into one or more of the following categories:

1. If they are experiencing symptoms related to COVID-19. Please click [here](#) to take the self-assessment test.
2. Have been tested positive for COVID-19 and not yet recovered.
3. If someone they have been in contact within the past 14 days has tested positive for COVID-19.

REGISTRATION

For all 2020 events, players will continue to receive a tee time e-mail within 3-4 days of the event. This e-mail will also detail any additional measures that are not covered below.

BEFORE YOU ARRIVE AT THE COURSE

All materials typically handed out at GTA AM Tour events will be eliminated. This can include, but is not limited to, Notice to Competitors, Pin Location Sheet, Official Scorecards. Event documents will be uploaded to the event information page for each event. Players can review all documents provided in advance and, if they so choose, print a copy to bring with them to the event.

1. We will indicate in the tee time e-mail what type of food & beverage services will be available. It is the player's responsibility to prepare for the day based on these guidelines
2. We will indicate in the tee time e-mail if the practice facilities are open
3. Water coolers have been removed from the golf course
4. Caddies and spectators are prohibited from all GTA AM Tour events in 2020

REGISTRATION AT THE COURSE

1. As you approach the parking lot of the host facility, you will be met by a greeter from the GTA AM Tour, and potentially one from the host facility as well. This person will provide you with VERY EXPLICIT instructions on how to proceed. We will confirm your tee time and make sure that you have arrived at the designated time as instructed in the tee-time e-mail
2. At your first event, and immediately upon arrival, please check in at registration to pick up your Tour Sponsor Gift Bag. Physical distancing measures will be in place at the registration area, and must be followed
3. After your first event, you will continue to physically check-in at registration
4. Please look for markers on the ground at registration to facilitate a safe distance from GTA AM Tour staff and fellow tour players
5. No skins game, hole in one challenge, or any other on-course games until further notice

MOBILE SCORING

1. We will be utilizing The GTA AM Tour's Live Scoring. One player per group will be designated to keep the scores for everyone. Players should also keep their own scores either on a mobile device or any items they have printed off
2. The Live Scoring marker for the group will be provided with the login password at the first tee. To prepare to keep score, the URL is: <https://gtaamtour.com/scoring>

ON THE COURSE

1. Caddies and spectators are prohibited at GTA AM TOUR events for the entire 2020 season. This rule will also apply to those wishing to bring someone that resides in the same household. No exceptions will be made
2. The Tour will continue to tee players off the first tee in threesomes, every 10 minutes, unless further guidelines have been handed down from governmental bodies or host clubs
3. No handshaking, simply say "Thank You" or bump putters at the end of your round
4. Players must always maintain a physical distance of at least 6 feet from each other
5. Bring hand sanitizer and use as often as you can, especially before and after using washrooms
6. Rakes have been removed from all bunkers. Players are encouraged to repair footprints using your feet to smooth the sand. The GTA AM Tour will implement a preferred lies policy in bunkers. Players will be entitled to mark their ball, smooth the area, and place the ball within 12" of the footprint, no closer to the hole

7. The flagstick must always remain in the hole. The Tour will be utilizing a new and safe product ([Bottoms Up Golf](#)), designed by Tour player Mike Hubbs. **DO NOT REMOVE THE FLAG**
8. If you use a motorized golf cart, only 1 player per cart will be permitted, unless the host facility has implemented government accepted dividers. Although host clubs will have a sanitation protocol in place for carts, all players will be required to wipe down all surfaces within, and outside the cart, after use. **PLAYERS WILL NOT BE ABLE TO PRE-BOOK CARTS, YOU MUST DO SO UPON ARRIVAL, AND WILL BE BASED ON A FIRST COME, FIRST SERVE BASIS**

AFTER YOUR ROUND

A GTA AM Tour scoring area will be established using social distancing measures. Players will be asked to read their scores allowed to our THE GTA AM TOUR Scoring Team for verification. Scoring will be final once you have left the scoring station.

There will be no playoffs. Winners will be determined by card-matching.

POST EVENT AND PRIZING

All per-event prizing will be e-mailed to winners after the competitions are closed, typically the next day. Other prizing will be handed out at the players next event.

Other Guidelines to Players

1. Encourage those players who are most susceptible to the virus to stay home. These will include players who have underlying health issues that can be affected by COVID-19 and those at a more vulnerable age group
2. Arrival times and check-in policy will be indicated on the tee time e-mail prior to each event. It will cover the following:
 - a. What time players can arrive on site (Based on tee time)
 - b. Availability of the practice facilities (Driving Range, Putting Green, Short Game Area)
3. Players must prepare for their rounds at their vehicles. All outside golf services will be closed to eliminate touch points
4. There will be a strong emphasis on walking at each event. Those requesting a power cart must do so through the pro shop and will be given out on a first come, first serve basis
5. Players must practice physical distancing at all time. Keeping a minimum of 6 feet away from other players, tour team and golf course staff. Any player that does not adhere to these measures could be asked to leave and potentially be banned from future events
6. Caddies and spectators are strictly prohibited for the 2020 season

GTA AM Tour Event Protocols

The GTA AM Tour is used to executing events at an extremely high level utilizing many features. With the goal to eliminate the amount of touch points for tour team members and players, adjustments will need to be made. Below is a model of what the GTA AM Tour will execute at each event. Management will put in place an event day execution plan for each area of the operations, including guidelines on how to make each task as safe as possible.

1. Placement of roadside welcome banner (If approved by host facility)
2. Placement of all sponsor banners (If approved by host facility)
3. Removal of all items on the first tee, other than the following:
 - a. GTA AM Tour Tent
 - b. 6ft Table
 - c. Cones on teeing area to indicate distance needed between players
 - d. Event sponsor banner
 - e. GTA AM Tour banner
 - f. A-Frame "Social Distancing" sign
4. Registration Protocols:
 - a. Use of trailer as main registration area
 - b. Set up 10x10 tent outside doors of trailer
 - c. Set up 6' tables at outside edges of tent to encourage distancing
 - d. Place cones on ground for players to stand at while waiting to register
 - e. At players first event, sponsor gift bags will be handed out to players
5. Elimination of prize ceremonies and removal of all items (Media Wall, TV, Tables, Prizing, Trophies)
6. Cancellation of tour organized skins game (Player conducted skins game available)
7. Cancellation of closest to the pin
8. The following on course measures will be taken:
 - a. Continue to set-up GTA AM Tour Flagsticks with Bottom's Up safe ball removal system
 - b. Continue to set-up GTA AM Tour Tee Markers (Black, Gold, Blue, White) and directional signs
 - c. Removal of GTA AM Tour Water Coolers
9. The following adjustment will be made to the competition material handed out to players at each event:
 - a. Pin location sheet and course guides will be loaded to each event info page on GTA AM Tour website
 - b. Live Scoring will continue to be used, and players will use their own mobile devices
 - c. Players will not be given scorecards and will use their mobile devices. Scoring procedures will be verbal after the round in the presence of a GTA AM Tour Official
 - d. Players will be able to use mobile devices for scoring or print off event scorecards from their account dashboard

Inclement Weather

Because there is no area of shelter that will be able to provide a safe practice of physical distancing, any event where the lightning detection system or air horns are used, all players must return to their vehicles and await further instructions.

If the players cannot go back on to the golf course, the following measures will take place:

If an entire flight that has finished 18 holes, there may be a winner awarded for that flight.

If an entire flight has finished 9 holes, but not 18 holes, there may be a winner awarded for that flight.

If the entire flight has not completed 9 holes, the event will be cancelled for that flight.

DEVIL'S PULPIT - HOLE #1 (PAR 4)



At over \$1 Million spent creating this masterpiece, the 1st Hole will surely take your breath away. With the Toronto Skyline visible on a clear day, feel free to "Grip it and Rip it" to the wide upper fairway. If you happen to miss right, the lower fairway offers a shorter approach to the green. Avoid the water at all costs and you will usually walk away with your Par!
Pay close attention on your putts, as all greens break away from the Escarpment!

DEVIL'S PULPIT - HOLE #2 (PAR 4)



This driveable Par 4 could leave you scratching your head depending on which strategy you choose. A lay-up short of the Pot Bunker will leave a flip wedge to a wide green; however, controlling distance is key if you want a Birdie Putt. If you manage to find the green from the tee, expect the ball to break to the back of the green despite how it appears. Starting with two (2) pars should clearly get your round headed in the right direction!

DEVIL'S PULPIT - HOLE #3 (PAR 3 - HIO)



The 1st Par 3 at Devil's Pulpit will test your distance control with the green branching out into three sections and large trees often disguising the prevailing wind. Although the flag may seem still, the hidden breeze could mean coming up short or drifting offline into one of the greenside bunkers.

DEVIL'S PULPIT - HOLE #4 (PAR 4)



The 4th Hole presents your first semi-blind tee shot of the day. Longer hitters must hug the right side to avoid going long into one of many fairway bunkers guarding the left side. The 2nd shot is more uphill than it appears, resulting in many balls coming up short. This green will offer some of the quickest and slowest putts on the course, depending on where you ball lands.

DEVIL'S PULPIT - HOLE #5 (PAR 4)



The Par 4 5th presents a fully blind tee shot over a large hill; however, the fairway is wide and gives the player multiple options. If you carry the ball far enough, the severe downslope will funnel the ball to the lower left of the fairway just 50-75 yards from the green. If you prefer a full shot, play to the top of the hill right centre and leave yourself a short iron to a shallow green. Par is a great score on this hole!

DEVIL'S PULPIT - HOLE #6 (PAR 4)



This medium length dogleg left will test your accuracy from the tee and on your approach. An Iron or Hybrid tee shot to the right centre is the best play, as driver is likely to overshoot the fairway and find some trouble. If you challenge the trees on the left and somehow manage to carry them, you will be rewarded with a flip wedge and perfect angle to a narrow deep green. This hole has many challenges, so play for Par.

DEVIL'S PULPIT - HOLE #7 (PAR 3)



The 7th Hole at the Pulpit is a peninsula type Par 3 where finding the green is key for Par. With a small front section, seeing a Pin there means a very accurate shot, but a rear pin leaves more room to find the surface. Missing the green on any side will find one of many pot bunkers or a steep slope where lie or stance may be an issue. Pay attention to the wind and pick your club accordingly.

DEVIL'S PULPIT - HOLE #8 (PAR 5)



The 8th Hole is the first of only two Par 5's you will face. At just 480 yards from the back tee, this Par 5 will yield its share of Birdies and Eagles. The hole plays slightly uphill and often into the wind, but two solid shots can reach this green.

Take advantage of this hole and go for those **SKINS BABY!**

DEVIL'S PULPIT - HOLE #9 (PAR 4)



The 9th Hole is a short Par 4 that will require an accurate 2nd shot depending on the angle to this wide green, which stretches to 53 yards at its longest point. You can safely play an Iron or Hybrid short of the center pot bunker or grab the big dog and challenge the front of the green. Either way, this hole should secure a Par for most players!

DEVIL'S PULPIT - HOLE #10 (PAR 4)



The 10th Hole could be considered the signature hole due to the large tree guarding the left side of the fairway. Despite its size, the tree is usually out of play with most players favouring the right side, which brings the right bunker into play. For the longest hitters, a drive over the tree can funnel right down to the front of the green, making Birdie a real possibility. Keep the ball straight on this hole and you are likely guaranteed your Par!

DEVIL'S PULPIT - HOLE #11 (PAR 4)



The Pulpit actually has three separate 11th hole options. #11 West is a dogleg left Par 4 with a pond left. Most will lay-up short of the right bunker to the widest part of the fairway, but big bombers can carry the hazard left depending on wind conditions. The green is extremely deep at 49 yards, so knowing the pin position is key for your approach. Green slopes toward the water, so a right pin will be very troublesome.

DEVIL'S PULPIT - HOLE #12 (PAR 4)



This short Par 4 dogleg left has several well placed bunkers to snag errant tee shots. The ideal play is a right to left ball flight short of the centre pot bunker, leaving a short iron approach to a green sloped back to front. This hole will be a birdie chance if you find the short grass, but can leave you struggling for bogey if you find a fairway bunker.

DEVIL'S PULPIT - HOLE #13 (PAR 5)



The 13th hole is the 2nd Par 5 at Devil's Pulpit that provides a classic Risk Reward hole that is reachable in two, but has plenty of trouble. With three (3) fairway options, the player must decide to play up the fairway right of the hazard for a great angle to the green OR go for the green with only 20 yards of depth.

This hole may see an Eagle, but will more likely see its share of others!

DEVIL'S PULPIT - HOLE #14 (PAR 4)



This straight away Par 4 can often play shorter due to the prevailing wind; however, that does not change the difficulty. With several pot bunkers off the tee, including a hidden bunker in the middle of the fairway, finding the fairway is key to hitting this green in regulation. Once on the green, everything slopes left to right, making putts from that direction very quick.

DEVIL'S PULPIT - HOLE #15 (PAR 4)



The dogleft left Par 4 offers a wide fairway, but a very difficult green with the entire hole sloping right to left. Most players will aim right centre and play short of the fairway bunker, but stopping the ball on the green from this angle is difficult. Bombers can carry the trees left, but an accurate shot is a must to avoid trouble. This green slopes sharper than it looks, so make sure to read putts from all angles!

DEVIL'S PULPIT - HOLE #16 (PAR 3 - CP)



The 16th is a medium-length Par 3 where any ball coming up short will certainly find a watery grave. Judging the wind here is key due to the shallow green and finding the correct tier is a must to make sure of a 2 putt. This is another hole that might yield some Birdies, Others, or the dreaded "X".

DEVIL'S PULPIT - HOLE #17 (PAR 4)



#17 is the first of two difficult Par 4's to end your round. Playing over 450 yards from the tips, this straight away hole has O.B. and trees the entire left side and a large fairway bunker preventing a bailout to the right. If you find the fairway, the deep green can mean a 3-4 club difference on your approach, so shoot for the centre of the green. Making Par here will likely gain you a stroke on the field.

DEVIL'S PULPIT - HOLE #18 (PAR 4)



Your final hole is a devilish baby dogleg Par 4 that requires a precise tee shot to avoid one of many fairway bunkers. The ideal line is over the left bunker to a down slope that will gain you some extra yards; however, finding this bunker means a sure bogey. The green is protected by a deep bunker right, so aim for the centre of the green. If you have paid attention, putts to the back of the green can be sneaky quick, despite the slope.
