

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# Brampton Golf Club Guest Information

## **Upon Arrival**

Upon arrival, please follow the driveway around to the Professional Shop, where you can drop off your golf equipment with a staff member. Park anywhere you'd like in the parking lot, minding our accessible parking spaces, and then please come inside the Professional Shop to check in for your round. Our staff will walk you through all the information you need before your round, including use of the practice areas and cart rentals.

## **Cell Phone Policy**

Mobile phones and other mobile devices are permitted on the golf course, practice facility and in the Clubhouse, but ringers must be turned off.

Clubhouse – texting and internet access are allowed, but phone conversations can only be held in the front foyer or outside.

Golf Course – if players must use their phone, they should do so to the side, away from play, without delaying players behind them or in their foursome, and while keeping up with the group in front of them. Texting and phone conversations are not allowed while driving the golf cart. Text messaging is permitted throughout the golf course and practice facilities.

## **Smoking & Vaping Policy**

Smoking (including vaping and e-cigarettes) is allowed in designated areas. Under the Smoke-Free Ontario Act, Brampton Golf Club follows the restrictions of nine (9) meters from entrance and exit ways required under SFOA for hospitals, private hospitals, psychiatric facilities, long-term care homes and independent health facilities.

The following areas are designated smoking/vaping areas:

- i. Seating area under the trees to the south-east of the practice putting green
- ii. Area near the putting green immediately across from the Clubhouse stairs

In addition, with the consent of all players within the tee-time grouping, smoking (including vaping and e-cigarettes) is permitted on the course; however, members are obligated to dispose of cigarette / cigar butts appropriately.

The legal use of recreational cannabis is permitted in designated smoking areas of the Club and while playing on the golf course, excluding practice facilities.

## **Gratuity Policy**

An automatic gratuity charge is applied to all dining and catering purchases.

# Dress Code

### Men



Golf shirts must have a collar, turtle neck or mock neck, and must be tucked in.



Golf shorts and pants must be tailored. Shorts must reach mid-thigh in length.



Tee shirts and tank tops not permitted.



Denim is not permitted.



Cargo pants and shorts with expandable pockets are not permitted.



Hats must be worn in the forward position.

### Women



Golf shorts and skirts must be a reasonable length.



Shirts may be worn untucked if they have a banded bottom designed to be worn that way.



Sleeveless and collarless shirts are permitted if shoulder straps are at least three inches wide



Tank tops and tops with low necklines are not permitted.



Yoga or exercise pants and shorts are not permitted.



Cargo pants and shorts with expandable pockets are not permitted.



Unreasonably short skirts or shorts, and/or exposed midriffs are not permitted

# Dress Code

## Clubhouse & F&B Outlets

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### Men



Casual or golf shorts and pants must be tailored. Shorts must reach mid-thigh in length.



Shirts may be worn untucked if designed to be worn that way. Plain tailored tee shirts are permitted.



Denim with no rips or distress is permitted.



Open-toed sandals are permitted.



Athletic wear including sweatpants, athletic shorts and tank tops is not permitted outside of the locker rooms or in transition to the exits.



Shower shoes are not permitted outside of the locker rooms or in transition to the exits. They are permitted in outdoor F&B outlets.



Hats are not permitted indoors. They are permitted on the patio.



Large logos, slogans or illustrations on apparel is not permitted.

### Women



Sleeveless and collarless dresses are permitted.



Golf or casual shorts and skirts must be a reasonable length.



Denim with no rips or distress is permitted.



Hats are permitted.



Open-toed sandals are permitted.



Shower shoes are not permitted outside of the locker rooms or in transition to the exits. They are permitted in outdoor F&B outlets.



Athletic wear including yoga pants, athletic shorts and tank tops is not permitted outside of the locker rooms or in transition to the exits.



Large logos, slogans or illustrations on apparel is not permitted.

### **NOTICE TO COMPETITORS**

This information supplements the 2025 Local Rules and Terms of Conditions for the GTA AM Tour. The current issue of the Golf Canada Rules of Golf govern play. **Any rules on the host club scorecard do not apply. Penalty for breach of a Local Rule is the general penalty, unless otherwise noted.**

1. **OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 18.2):** See GTA AM Tour Hard Card for how Out of Bounds is defined.

**HOLES #9 & #15:** If during play of the 9<sup>th</sup> or 15<sup>th</sup> holes, a ball comes to rest on or beyond the entrance road, it is out of bounds, even if it comes to rest on another part of the course that is in bounds for other holes.

**HOLES #2, #10 & #18:** The range to the left of #2 and to the right of #10 and #18 is out of bounds and is defined by white stakes.

2. **HOST CLUB DROP ZONES ARE NOT AVAILABLE:** Any Drop Zone available at this event will be indicated by a GTA AM Tour sign.
3. **PENALTY AREAS (Rule 17):** Red and yellow lines define the edge of the penalty area. Where penalty areas are not marked with lines, the change in the height of the grass defines the edge of the penalty area. Where there is no change in the height of the grass, the penalty area is defined by its natural boundaries. Unmarked penalty areas are red penalty areas.
4. **OBSTRUCTIONS AND GROUND UNDER REPAIR (Rule 16.1 applies):** Areas that are ornamental garden beds, turf nurseries, decorative flowerbeds or the clubhouse patio are No Play Zones that are to be treated as Ground Under Repair. Players must proceed under Rule 16.1f. Any areas of ground under repair will be marked or noted.

**Green Depth = 28 yds (-3)**

*Your opening hole is a short straight away Par 4 that plays a club less off the tee and at least a club extra on your approach. Hitting the green is key here to guarantee Par, but below the hole is a must if you want to start with a Birdie!*

*Beware of the false front or you may end up off the putting surface!*

## Hole #2 (Par 5)

**Green Depth = 24 yds (0)**

*This baby dogleg right Par 5 is reachable in two for long hitters depending on wind conditions; however, protect against the pond left of the green, which lurks about 90 yards away. The ideal line is right centre off the tee but avoid the Fairway Bunkers. O.B. Lurks down the entire right side, but it won't be in play for most tee balls.*

*This hole may yield some Birdies!*

**Green Depth = 35 yds (-12)**

***Your 1st Par 3 at Brampton is also the shortest Par 3 you will face.***

***A wedge or short-iron below the hole will leave a Birdie chance; however, missing left or right will leave a tough up and down with minimal green to work with!***

***Beware of the bunkers on both sides, as sand saves are hard to come by!***

***This is probably the shortest Par 4 on the GTA Am Tour! lol***

**Green Depth = 36 yds (-2)**

*This long Par 4 will test your skill as it usually plays even longer than the card indicates. The right of centre is the ideal tee shot, but avoid the right rough, or you may be forced to lay up.*

*If you navigate two solid shots, be sure not to lose your concentration or you will find yourself with a 3-putt bogey.*

**Green Depth = 29 yds (-4)**

*After playing the #3 Handicap Hole, you are tested again by the toughest hole at Brampton. This straight & lengthy Par 4 has an extremely wide green that is lacking in depth.*

*The long hitter can carry the trees down the right for a mid-iron approach; however, distance control is key on the approach if you want to hit this green. If you make Par here, pat yourself on the back!*

**Green Depth = 40 yds (-15)**

*After two difficult holes, you get a drivable Par 4 depending on the tee you play. Although tempting the long hitter, a play to 100 yards and a wedge to the green often means an easy Par.*

*Beware of this green, as a large slope splits this green. Being on the right section is a must in order to make a Birdie!*

**Green Depth = 40 yds (-3)**

*The Par 3 7th Hole is a long Par 3, which tempts you to bailout right; however, getting up and down from the right is more difficult than the bunkers due to the right to left slope of the green.*

*To score Birdie or Par, make sure to be left of the Pin!*

**Green Depth = 40 yds (-1)**

*This short Par 4 is gettable for both the long and short player. Long players can carry the willow tree down the right for a flip wedge to the green, but a play to the 150-yard marker will also yield some Birdies.*

*Either way, stay short of the Back Pin at all costs or test your nerves with an extremely difficult chip!*

**Green Depth = 52 yds (-16)**

*This long Par 5, bending slightly right, is a three-shotter for most players. As with most of the holes at Brampton, playing from 100 yards is your best chance at a Birdie.*

*With the deepest green on the course at 52 yards, club selection is key to finding yourself with a Birdie chance as you end the front nine.*

**Green Depth = 26 yds (0)**

*The 10th Hole at Brampton is another hole that plays much longer than advertised. This is the most important hole to find the short grass in order to control your approach to the green.*

*As with most holes, stay below the hole or risk a bogey!*

**Green Depth = 25 yds (0)**

*The 11th Hole is a medium length Par 3, where the largest defence is the ridge splitting The green from the front left to the back right.*

*You must be on the correct side for a makeable Birdie putt, but anywhere on the green can yield a 2 putt.*

**Green Depth = 42 yds (+5)**

*This short Par 4 gives most players a breather if they play smart. The pond off the tee is deceptively close, so a tee shot to the 150-yard marker is most desirable for a good approach shot to this narrow green!*

*Avoid the Pond left of the green and it should be an easy Par!*

**Green Depth = 20 yds (+3)**

*This Par 3 is medium-length, where the wind often plays havoc with your tee shot. A front left pin placement will yield the most Birdies, but avoid the front bunker for your best chance at Par.*

*Missing short and left will give you a makeable up and down, as you will be chipping into the slope of this green. Some scoring holes await, so be patient here and don't get greedy!*

**Green Depth = 32 yds (+2)**

*The 14th Hole is a straightaway long Par 5 that is still reachable by long hitters if they carry the right bunkers off the tee. Aim at the Red Maple Tree off the tee and find the short grass.*

*There is a ridge splitting the left and right of this green, so a lay-up to 100 yards will give the best chance to find the correct section.*

**Green Depth = 34 yds (-10)**

*This short Par 4 gives players multiple choices off the tee from Driver to long irons. Play down the left side for the best angle to the green and control your distance for a chance at a Birdie.*

*Another ridge splits the front and the rear of the green, so make sure to find the correct level if you want a red number on your scorecard!*

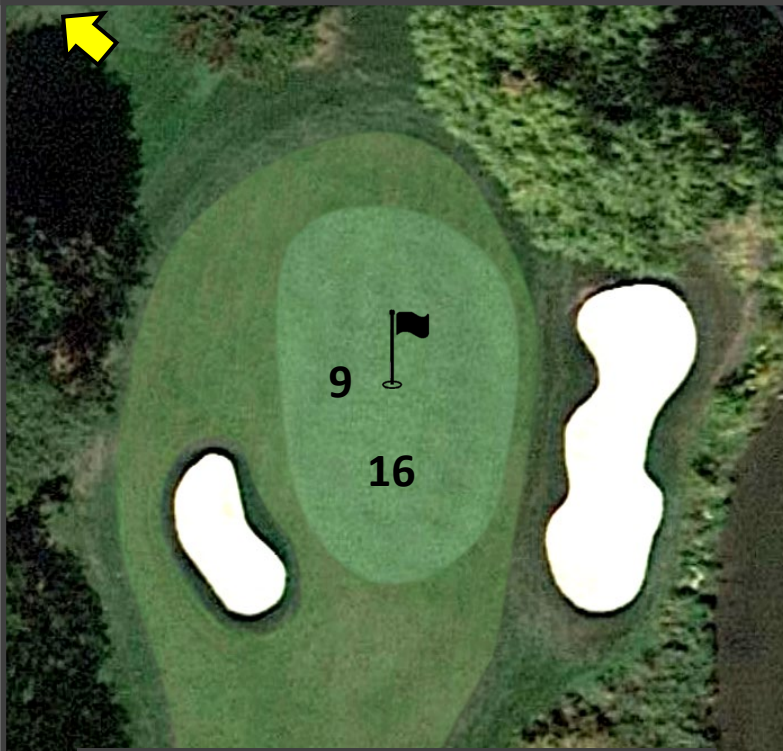

**Green Depth = 30 yds (+1)**

*Considered by many to be the signature hole at Brampton, this elevated Par 3 can stretch to over 200 yards from the tips. Despite the beauty, make sure to check the wind, which is rarely felt from the tee.*

*A 2-putt Par is much more than acceptable!*

**Green Depth = 32 yds (-5)**

*The penultimate hole at Brampton is a tricky dogleg right Par 5 that will tease every player based on the yardage, but a creek cutting across the fairway has gobbled up many tee shots.*

*Put your courage in your pocket & play this one as a 3-shot hole for your best chance at a Birdie!*

*The green slopes steeply from the back to the front with a false front coming into play for the front pin, so distance control is most important for success on this hole!*
