OUR HISTORY



TWO CANADIAN DESIGN LEGENDS HAVE COMBINED TO BRING YOU A DELIGHTFUL DOSE OF GOLF AT ITS BEST. STANLEY THOMPSON CARVED OUT THE ORIGINAL NINE HOLES IN 1922. ROBBIE ROBINSON INTEGRATED A SECOND NINE IN 1972, CREATING A SEAMLESS ROUTING THAT MAY LOOK FAIRLY INNOCUOUS ON PAPER, BUT WILL BE APPRECIATED FOR ITS SUBTLE CHARMS. THE BRIARS IS THE EPITOME OF THE OLD-STYLE COURSE.

THE BRIARS GOLF CLUB THAT OPENED IN 1922 WAS DESIGNED BY THE RENOWNED DESIGNER STANLEY THOMPSON. THE BRIARS GOLF CLUB PROUDLY TAKES OUR PLACE IN GOLF HISTORY ALONG WITH ANY LEGENDARY COURSES THAT CAME TO LIFE UNDER HIS CREATIVE DIRECTION.

THE DEPRESSION ENVIRONMENT OF THE 1930'S MAY HAVE INFLICTED HARDSHIP ON MANY CANADIANS, BUT THE BRIARS GOLF CLUB COMMUNITY WEATHERED THE STORM QUITE NICELY. THE CLUB ENTERED INTO A MORE FORMAL ARRANGEMENT WITH J.D. SIBBALD JUST BEFORE THE WAR, WHICH RESULTED IN A PERPETUAL LEASE ON THE LAND WHICH THEN CONTAINED OUR ORIGINAL NINE HOLES. OUR FACILITIES CONSISTED OF THE ORIGINAL CLUBHOUSE (NOW THE BRIARS TEAHOUSE) AND A 600 SQUARE FOOT CADDIE AND PRO SHOP.

MEMBERSHIP: ALMOST THE ENTIRE MEMBERSHIP WAS MADE UP OF COTTAGERS WITH PERHAPS SIX OR EIGHT LOCAL SUTTON RESIDENTS. THE BY-LAWS RESTRICTED MEMBERSHIP TO THOSE WITH RESIDENCES WITHIN 25 ROAD MILES OF THE CLUB. THERE WAS NO BRIARS RESORT UNTIL 1942. THE ANNUAL FEE STRUCTURE IN THE 30'S WAS AROUND \$35 FOR SENIORS, \$10 FOR NOMINEES, AND \$5 FOR JUNIORS. GREEN FEES WERE AROUND \$1 PER ROUND. THERE WAS NO INITIATION FEE TO JOIN THE CLUB. THIS CAME INTO BEING IN THE LATE 1960'S; SHARES SOLD FOR \$25.

GOLF: I.F. (DAL) DALGLEISH, BROUGHT IN FROM EDINBURGH, SCOTLAND, WAS THE CLUB PROFESSIONAL FROM THE EARLY 1920'S UNTIL HIS RETIREMENT AROUND 1965. HE RAN EVERYTHING WITH HELP, USUALLY FROM ONE OF THE JUNIOR MEMBERS, TO CLEAN CLUBS AND MIND THE SHOP. DAL WAS A GOOD TEACHER AND DEVELOPED MANY EXCELLENT GOLFERS WHO WENT ON TO FAME ELSEWHERE.

HE RAN THE SHOP...GAVE LESSONS...BOOKED GREEN FEES...SOLD MERCHANDISE...REPAIRED CLUBS...WAS BOTH CLUB SECRETARY AND TREASURER, KEPT BOOKS AND PAID BILLS. HE WORKED A SEVEN-DAY WEEK, 12-14 HOURS A DAY, RAN THE SATURDAY NIGHT DANCES AND HANDLED THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE ANNUAL MEETING. HE IS AN IMPORTANT PART OF OUR HISTORY.

THE COURSE ITSELF WAS A GREAT CHALLENGE FROM THE OUTSET, AND MANY CLUB COMPETITIONS WERE CONDUCTED. EXCEPT FOR THE LADIES AND THOSE ON HOLIDAYS, ALMOST ALL PLAY WAS ON SATURDAYS AND SUNDAYS. STARTING TIMES WEREN'T REQUIRED AND ALL AVAILABLE PLAYING HOURS WERE USED TO ADVANTAGE. THERE WAS NO PARKING IN THE PRO SHOP AREA - THAT WAS THE CADDIE COMPOUND. CARS WERE PARKED BEHIND THE CLUBHOUSE. MANY GOLF AFICIONADOS CONSIDERED THE BRIARS THE BEST NINE-HOLE COURSE IN ONTARIO.

GREENS: DURING THE 1930'S, 40'S AND 50'S, THE COURSE WAS MAINTAINED BY A HEAD GREENSKEEPER AND THREE OR FOUR MEN. STAFF HAD A TRACTOR WITH A SET OF GOOD MOWERS TO DO FAIRWAYS, TEES AND APRONS. TWO GREENSMOWERS (WEIGHING ABOUT 150 POUNDS EACH) TOOK TWO MEN ALMOST A FULL DAY TO MOW NINE GREENS. THIS OCCURRED EVERY TWO OR THREE DAYS. THE ROUGH WAS CUT WITH SCYTHES - ONCE EACH IN JUNE, JULY AND AUGUST. A TEAM OF HORSES PULLED A CART WHERE THE RAKED UP HAY WAS DEPOSITED. A WORKDAY/NIGHT WAS LONG AND HARD BECAUSE ALL WATERING OF GREENS WAS DONE MANUALLY IN THE EVENINGS.

HOUSE: THE ORIGINAL CLUBHOUSE (NOW USED BY BRIARS RESORT GUESTS) WAS BUILT IN 1926 AND WAS THE HUB OF MANY CLUB ACTIVITIES. SATURDAY NIGHT DANCES WERE HELD ON TEN SUMMER WEEKENDS TO LIVE BANDS. THE DANCES INCLUDED A MIDNIGHT SUPPER OF SCRAMBLED EGGS AND BACON. STANDARD TIME WAS USED TO END THE DANCES AT 1:00 A.M., BUT QUITE OFTEN EV AND PAUL HIGGINS WOULD HAVE THE BAND BACK TO THEIR COTTAGE FOR MORE FUN AND GAMES. JUNIORS HAD WEDNESDAY NIGHT DANCES. MASQUERADE NIGHTS... CHILDREN'S DAYS...LADIES GOLF LUNCHEONS...INTER-CLUB EVENTS, ETC. ALL MADE FOR A BUSY SOCIAL SCHEDULE. THE JACKSON'S POINT YACHT CLUB SAILED EVERY SATURDAY AND THEIR MEMBERS OFTEN JOINED GOLF CLUB MEMBERS AT SATURDAY DANCES. THE CLUBHOUSE WAS REPAINTED IN 1936 FOR A TOTAL COST OF \$50, INCLUDING PAINT. STANLEY ST. JOHN'S EIGHT-PIECE BAND CAME FROM TORONTO EVERY SATURDAY NIGHT FOR A COST OF \$50 PER NIGHT. AH...THOSE WERE THE DAYS!

FINANCIAL: OVER THE YEARS, MUCH MONEY HAS BEEN SAVED AS A RESULT OF THE VOLUNTARY EFFORTS OF THE MEMBERSHIP. THE CLUB WAS NEVER VERY STRONG FINANCIALLY IN ITS FIRST THIRTY YEARS, BUT IT DIDN'T NEED TO BE - THANKS TO THE EFFORTS OF INDIVIDUAL MEMBERS. IT IS INTERESTING TO NOTE THAT OVER THE YEARS NUMEROUS BANK LOANS WITH THE BANK OF NOVA SCOTIA IN SUTTON WERE SECURED BY PROVIDING A LIST OF TWENTY OR TWENTY FIVE PROMINENT MEMBERS OF THE CLUB.

EXCEPT FOR A CART LOAN IN 1991, NO ASSETS HAVE EVER BEEN PLEDGED AGAINST A LOAN, AND TYPICAL OF OUR MEMBERSHIP SUPPORT, TWO VOLUNTARY DEBENTURE ISSUES WERE UNDERWRITTEN IN 1977 AND 1991 BY A GROUP OF OUR MEMBERS TO ASSIST IN VITAL CLUB FINANCING.

IN 1976-77 THE CLUB WAS OPERATING WITH A WORKING CAPITAL DEFICIENCY OF \$56,000. NOBODY MUCH WORRIED ABOUT THIS TECHNICAL BANKRUPTCY. THE BOARD AND MEMBERS TRIMMED THEIR SAILS AND WORKED THEIR WAY OUT OF IT. THE PRESENT FINANCIAL WELL BEING OF THE CLUB WOULD BOGGLE THE MINDS OF OUR FOUNDERS.

GENERAL: THE CLUBHOUSE HAS GONE THROUGH THREE RENOVATIONS, TWO OF WHICH WERE FINANCED IN PART BY VOLUNTARY MEMBERSHIP DEBENTURES. THE COURSE ENLARGEMENT FROM NINE TO EIGHTEEN HOLES IN 1972 WAS OBVIOUSLY THE MOST SIGNIFICANT EVENT IN THE HISTORY OF THE CLUB. THE ANONYMOUS CONTRIBUTION OF \$150,000 TOWARDS THIS PROJECT WILL FOREVER BE APPRECIATED. AT THE TIME, THIS WAS A TREMENDOUS SUM OF MONEY BY ANYONE'S STANDARDS. THE FOUR CLUB SECRETARIES PRIOR TO 1990 WORKED IN A DIFFERENT FASHION - EVERYTHING IN THOSE DAYS WAS DONE MANUALLY. MEMBERSHIP MIX AND GROWTH OCCURRED AS THE CLUB EVOLVED.

PERSONALITIES ARE WHAT MAKE ANY SOCIAL ORGANIZATION. NOW AT THE BRIARS THERE ARE A LARGE NUMBER OF MEMBERS WHO HAVE COME FROM COMMUNITIES OUTSIDE OF GEORGINA. THIS HAS BROUGHT NEW STRENGTHS TO THE CLUB AND TO THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS. HOPEFULLY THE BEST TRADITIONS OF THE CLUB WILL BE PERPETUATED BY ALL WHO FOLLOW IN THE FOOTSTEPS OF THOSE WHO HAVE CONTRIBUTED SO MUCH OVER THE YEARS.

BRIARS GOLF CLUB - HOLE #1 (PAR 4)



The 1st Hole at The Briar's is a medium length Par 4 that often plays longer than advertised due to the prevailing wind. The ideal tee shot is a driver or 3 wood with enough distance to bypass the large tree down the left; however, an errant shot to the right could find the out of bounds. You will then face a mid-iron to a small subtle green where Par is a good score!

The 2nd Hole is another straight away Par 4 without fairway bunkers; however, trees line both sides with a lateral hazard down the right side. Two (2) solid shots will find a medium size green with subtle breaks from back to front. Short is better than long if you miss, which gives you a simple chip to save your Par!

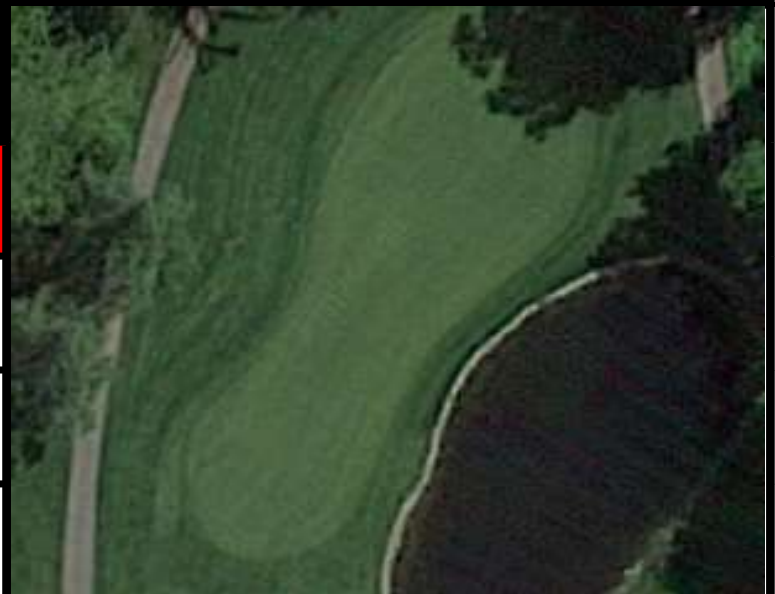
BRIARS GOLF CLUB - HOLE #3 (PAR 3)



The 3rd hole is a medium length Par 3 where anything missed right will find a watery grave. With an angled green, a back pin placement will surely test your distance control. Once on the green, most people will assume the green breaks to the water, but the green is flatter than it appears.

This reachable Par 5 requires two good shots to find yourself with an Eagle putt. Avoid the fairway bunker from the tee and go for the green OR lay up down the right side for the best angle to this green. O.B. Lurks down the right side of this hole, so many will bailout left. This hole will yield many Pars and some Birdies!

The 5th Hole is a picturesque short Par 3 where a wedge is all you need. With the green protected by multiple bunkers and a pond short, anything from a 2 to a 5 can take place. Go at the pin for Birdie or shoot for the wide part of the green to secure a Par. Putts will be quick toward the water.

As with many holes at The Briars, a straight ball is rarely the best play. This baby dogleg requires a left to right shot to give you the best chance of hitting the short grass. Most will be left with a mid-short iron into this small green with a steep ridge dividing it and a deep bunker short. This hole can be sneaky difficult, so don't be disappointed with your Par.

This slight dogleg right Par 4 narrows the farther you hit your tee shot, so choose your shot accordingly. Heavy trees line the right side, so a play down the left centre is ideal to approach this green. With a long green sloping back to front, picking the right club is often difficult. Pay attention to your pin sheet here if you expect to make a Birdie!

The 8th Hole is a sharp dogleg left where driver is rarely the play for most players. If you don't want to challenge the large pine trees protecting the left side, this tee shot requires a right to left ball flight to hit this fairway. Don't go too far, or find yourself reaching for a ball retriever. The green is relatively fair, so putts can be made from all directions. This is a good birdie hole!

Even with a layup, a controlled approach to this green will give you a Birdie look. There are bunkers protecting this green right, left, and short, so check your pin sheet and wind before choosing your club.

This short Par 4 requires a 225-250 yard tee ball that finds the short grass. With many overhanging trees on this hole, a right centre shot will give the player an unobstructed approach shot. The green slopes back to front, so putts to a back pin are slower than expected.

Stay below the hole on your approach and you will guarantee your par with a good chance at making a Birdie putt or chip! If your adventurous OR looking for SKINS, see the **CRAZY PLAY BELOW!**

This difficult Par 4 is a dogleg left where distance and accuracy are a must to hit the green in regulation. Lateral hazard lurks the entire left side, so most people bailout right, leaving a difficult approach off a steep slope. The green is deep and protected by bunkers left, so if you hit this green in regulation, consider it an admirable task. Par is a great score on this hole!

Play your tee ball to the corner of the dogleg and then layup to your desired yardage to ensure a birdie putt. Make sure to read the putts from all sides, as this green offers up some subtle deceptive breaks.

Missing left may find some tree trouble, but a shot down the right will likely leave a mid to short iron approach to the green. This green is relatively flat, but is very long and requires precise distance control. Make sure you double check your pin sheet here!

The 17th hole is a 90 degree dogleg right Par 4 where the risk of cutting the corner is not worth the reward. Play a max tee shot of 225-250 yards and leave yourself 140-160 yards for your 2nd shot. The green is protected by water short right and left, so commit to the approach and escape with a 4 and you can almost guarantee making a shot to the field.

The final hole at the Briars requires a well placed tee shot with a right to left ball flight to find the short grass. Accuracy is more important than power on this hole, so avoid the O.B. that lurks the entire right side. Most players will then find a mid-iron to a kidney shaped green. The green has some subtle slopes, but 2 putts will be more likely than 3 putts.
