NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

This information supplements the 2022 Local Rules and Terms of Conditions for the GTA AM Tour. The current issue of the Golf Canada Rules of Golf govern play. **Any rules on the host club scorecard do not apply. Penalty for breach of a Local Rule is the general penalty, unless otherwise noted.**

1. **OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 18.2):** Defined by the line between the course-side points at ground level of white lines, dots or stakes and fence posts defining out of bounds. A ball is out of bounds when it is beyond any wall defining the boundary of the course. A ball coming to rest on or beyond a road defined as Out of Bounds is Out of Bounds, even though it may lie on another part of the Course that is in bounds for other holes.

HOLE #7: During play of hole #7, the 8th hole on the left side, defined by white stakes, is **out of bounds**. During play on hole #7, the white stakes are boundary objects and are immovable. The player is not entitled to relief.

HOLE #8: During play of hole #8, the white stakes on the left side have no meaning. A ball on the 7th hole is in play and on the course. During play on hole #8, the white stakes are immovable obstructions.

2. **HOST CLUB DROP ZONES ARE NOT AVAILABLE:** Any Drop Zone available at this event will be indicated by a GTA AM Tour sign.
3. **PENALTY AREAS (Rule 17):** Red and yellow lines define the edge of the penalty area. Where penalty areas are not marked with lines, the change in the height of the grass defines the edge of the penalty area. Where there is no change in the height of the grass, the penalty area is defined by its natural boundaries. Unmarked penalty areas are red penalty areas.

DROP ZONES AVAILABLE:

HOLE #11: For a ball that enters the penalty area before the fairway, another ball may be put in play using Rule 17.1d, or *as an additional option may use the Drop Zone* located in front of the pond.

4. **OBSTRUCTIONS AND GROUND UNDER REPAIR (Rule 16.1 applies):** Any areas of ground under repair will be marked or noted.

NO PLAY ZONES: Areas that are ornamental garden beds, turf nurseries or decorative flowerbeds are No Play Zones that are to be treated as Ground Under Repair. Player must proceed under Rule 16.1f.

How To Use This Guide



Green Depth = 32 yds

The image above illustrates the green complex (aligned to the most likely angle of approach) with the approximate flag location for the event. Also shown is the green depth in yards (measured straight, from the centre of the fairway, along the most likely angle of approach). Note: your specific angle of approach will determine the actual green depth along your line of play and may be different than indicated.

This text box provides pro tips and general information about the hole.

The hole image on the right indicates distances from spots in the teeing ground (●●●) to various locations in the landing area (○). The distance text is colour-coded to match the teeing ground spots. The actual tee marker positions will vary, but differences can be quickly paced off or estimated. Standard 100 ●, 150 ○ and 200 ● yard markers (to the centre of the green) may also be shown.

The chart below shows the event yardages for the hole for each flight.

Diamondback - Hole #1 (Par 5)



Green Depth = 30 yds

The opening hole is a great downhill Par 5 with O.B. down the left side. Hit the fairway, and you're in great shape to go for the green. You will find two fairway bunkers on either side of the fairway and two more bunkers near the green. Eagle and Birdie could be made here, but like most greens at Diamondback, this one has multiple tiers to test your putts. This green has an uphill slope.

Diamondback - Hole #2 (Par 4)



Green Depth = 38 yds

This long Par 4 will challenge everyone in the field. O.B. can be found on the left side and you must carry some water before getting to the fairway.

Three bunkers await you at the green, which slopes hard to the left. If you make a Par, you will be off to a great start.

Diamondback - Hole #3 (Par 3)



Green Depth = 31 yds



The first Par 3 plays a little tricky, as you will have to carry some water first and avoid the three (3) greenside bunkers.

The middle of the green is ideal, but if you find a greenside bunker, you can still save your Par, and Par is a good score on this hole.

Diamondback - Hole #4 (Par 4)



Green Depth = 37 yds

This hole features water on the left and a few fairway bunkers to catch an errant drive. If you can cut the corner over the right edge, you will be in good shape for your approach shot into the green. The green is open in front so the low-ball hitters can bounce it onto the front pin!

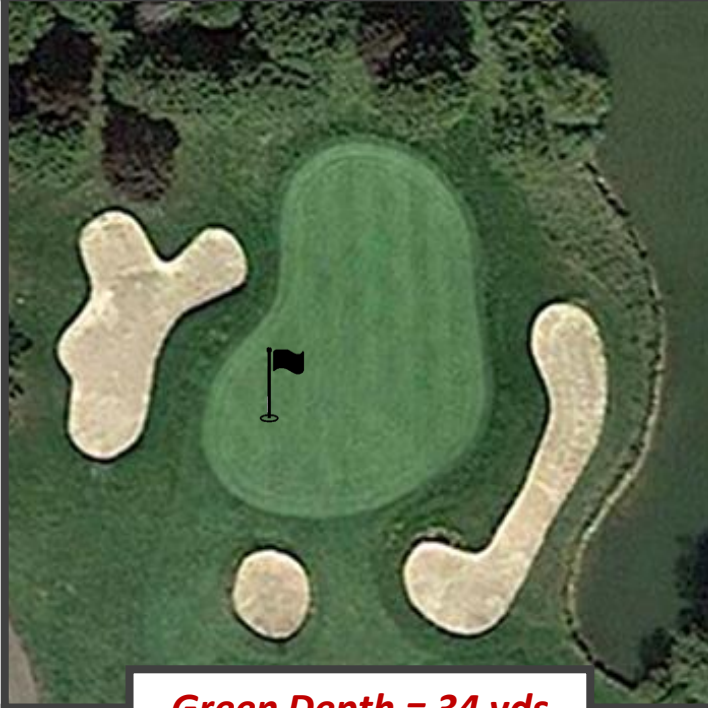

Diamondback - Hole #5 (Par 5)



Green Depth = 34 yds

This Par 5 plays uphill to start with lots of room off the tee, then down on your approach to the green. Be sure to stay left on your approach shot, as there is a penalty area short right of the green that will be sure to swallow wayward shots. Birdies can be made on this hole for the bold players!

Diamondback - Hole #6 (Par 4)



Green Depth = 25 yds

Leave the driver in the bag on this tough Par 4. Check your yardage because you can find the water hazard if you go long.

Your approach shot to the green is uphill, so make sure that you take an extra club. Two bunkers protect the right side of the green, while one bunker protects the left.

Diamondback - Hole #7 (Par 4)



Green Depth = 35 yds

The 7th Hole features internal out-of-bounds down the left. The 7th fairway runs adjacent to the 8th, so if you go left, expect a blue flag. Fairway bunkers will come into play on this hole, so play to the right side of the fairway for a clear shot at the green. Water also comes into play right of the green, so congratulate yourself if you write down a four on the card.

Diamondback - Hole #8 (Par 4)



Green Depth = 30 yds

The 8th hole is Diamondback's tricky signature hole, and you must play smart. Don't forget the O.B. separating the 7th Fairway. On your second shot, an island green with a bunker on the left awaits you. Make sure to pick the correct club, or risk swimming with the sharks!

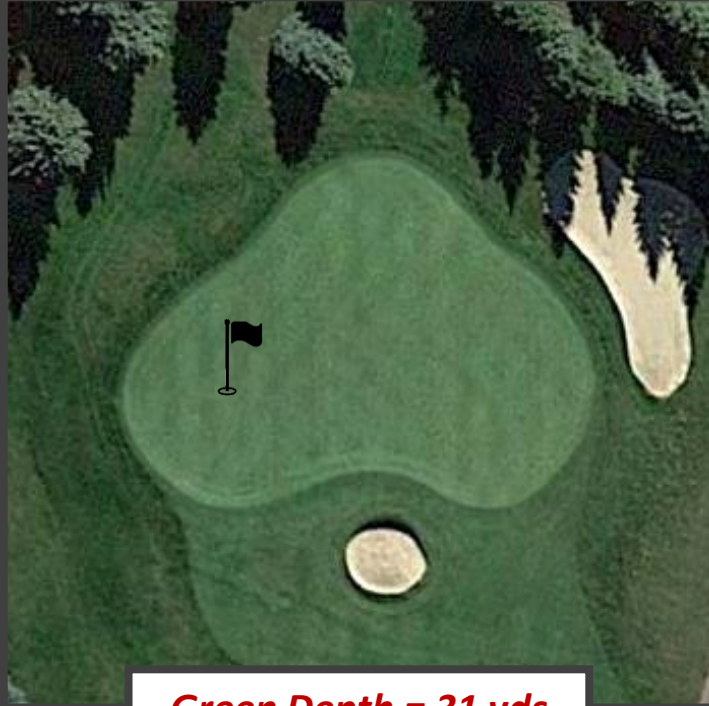

Diamondback - Hole #9 (Par 3)



Green Depth = 31 yds

This Par 3 plays long and uphill with bunkers protecting the green both short and right. The green is large and inviting, so pick the correct club and make your two (2) putt.

Just like Hole #3, Par is a solid score to round out the front nine, but a well-placed tee shot could result in a Birdie!

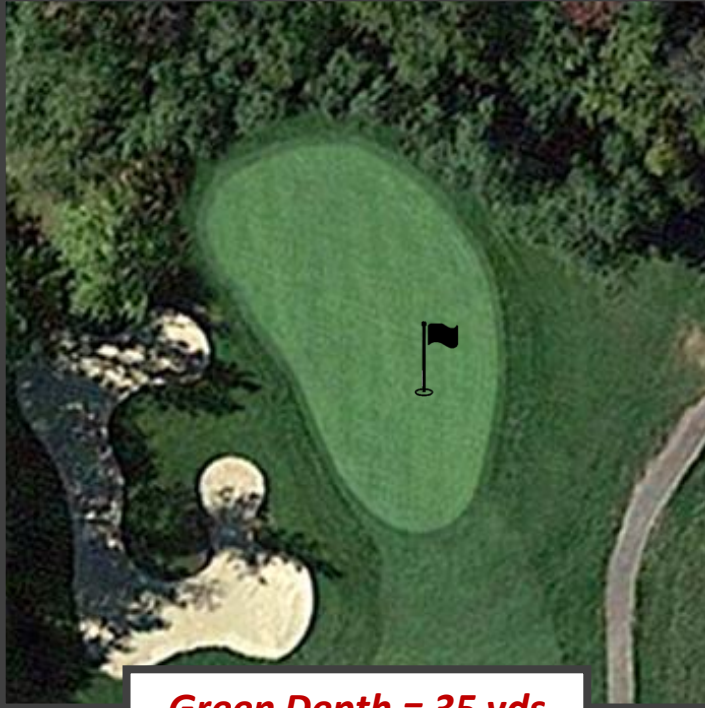

Diamondback - Hole #10 (Par 4)



Green Depth = 35 yds

Your inward 9 starts with a hard dogleg right with a downhill tee shot and uphill approach. Too far right, and you will find yourself in the thick stuff. A large bunker protects the left side of the green, so avoiding this is key to securing your Par.

Diamondback - Hole #11 (Par 5)



Green Depth = 36 yds

This is a fantastic Par 5 dogleg left where the end of the split fairway is only in play for the bombers! If you can reach the end, then go for the green in 2.

Most will lay up in the 2nd fairway for a wedge approach into this protected green.

Stay away from the left side, and you will have a good chance for a Birdie.

Diamondback - Hole #12 (Par 3)



Green Depth = 32 yds

This Par 3 will play difficult as bunkers on the left and right heavily guard the narrow green.

Trees also line the right side of the hole, making it difficult to choose the right club. As with most Par 3's at Diamondback, Par is a good score.

Diamondback - Hole #13 (Par 4)



Green Depth = 35 yds

This interesting Par 4 dogleg right can cause trouble for many players. Don't take on too much of the corner; otherwise, the trees may block you out.

If you play aggressively and go through the fairway, expect to find a watery grave. Play to the 150-yard marker for your best chance at success.

Diamondback - Hole #14 (Par 4)



Green Depth = 35 yds

The 14th hole greets you with another sharp dogleg, this one to the left. Your ideal shot is toward the right bunker, but do your best to avoid reaching it. This will leave you 150-175 yards to a green well protected by a large and challenging bunker to the right.

Diamondback - Hole #15 (Par 3)



Green Depth = 32 yds

This Par 3 is protected by bunkers left and right. Anywhere on the green is good; however, remember that the green is undulating and can be tricky. A two-putt Par is a goal here, but hitting it close will give you a chance at a SKIN!

Diamondback - Hole #16 (Par 4)



Green Depth = 30 yds

This solid Par 4 requires a good tee shot to avoid O.B. lurking the entire left side and trees guarding the right. Some will challenge the fairway bunker, leaving less than 100 yards to the green, but the safe play is short of the fairway bunker. Avoid the several bunkers around the green to ensure an easy Par.

Diamondback - Hole #17 (Par 4)



Green Depth = 34 yds

Your penultimate hole plays as the longest Par 4 on the course. The hole plays straight with the right fairway bunker seeing more balls than expected. A Birdie here will put cash in your pocket, but if you mess up here, your dreams of lifting the Trophy can come crashing down hard and fast! Be careful!

Diamondback - Hole #18 (Par 5)



Green Depth = 35 yds

This closing Par 5 will play as a three-shot Par 5 for anyone not named DeChambeau. A solid drive and good layup will give you a perfect angle into the green and a great look at Birdie.

Don't let the beauty of the approach shot lull your focus, as many rounds have often been won or lost on this hole!
