#### NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

This information supplements the 2025 Local Rules and Terms of Conditions for the GTA AM Tour. The current issue of the Golf Canada Rules of Golf govern play. **Any rules on the host club scorecard do not apply. Penalty for breach of a Local Rule is the general penalty, unless otherwise noted.**

1. **OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 18.2):** See GTA AM Tour Hard Card for how Out of Bounds is defined.

**HOLES #1, #2 & #3:** The driving range to the right of holes #1, #2 and #3 is Out of Bounds and defined by a white line.

**HOLE #9:** The parking lot to the right of hole #9 is Out of Bounds and defined by the edge of the gravel.

2. **HOST CLUB DROP ZONES ARE NOT AVAILABLE:** Any Drop Zone available at this event will be indicated by a GTA AM Tour sign.

3. **PENALTY AREAS (Rule 17):** Red and yellow lines define the edge of the penalty area. Where penalty areas are not marked with lines, the change in the height of the grass defines the edge of the penalty area. Where there is no change in the height of the grass, the penalty area is defined by its natural boundaries. Unmarked penalty areas are red penalty areas.

**NO PLAY ZONES:** Red penalty areas marked with red stakes with green tops, located on holes #6, #12, #13, #15 and #16 are NO PLAY ZONES.

The player **MUST** take penalty relief under Rule 17.1d by adding one penalty stroke. **Players are not permitted to enter No Play Zones.**

For a ball in the General Area where the player has interference from a No Play Zone with their stance or swing, the player **MUST** take free relief (Rule 16.1f) by finding the nearest point of complete relief, no nearer to the hole and establish a relief area of one club-length.

#### **DROP ZONES AVAILABLE:**

**HOLE #16:** For a ball that enters the penalty area in front and to the right of the green, another ball may be put in play using Rule 17.1d(1), (2) or (3), or *as an additional option may use the Drop Zone* located on the small tee deck to the left.

4. **OBSTRUCTIONS AND GROUND UNDER REPAIR (Rule 16.1 applies):** Any areas of ground under repair will be marked or noted.

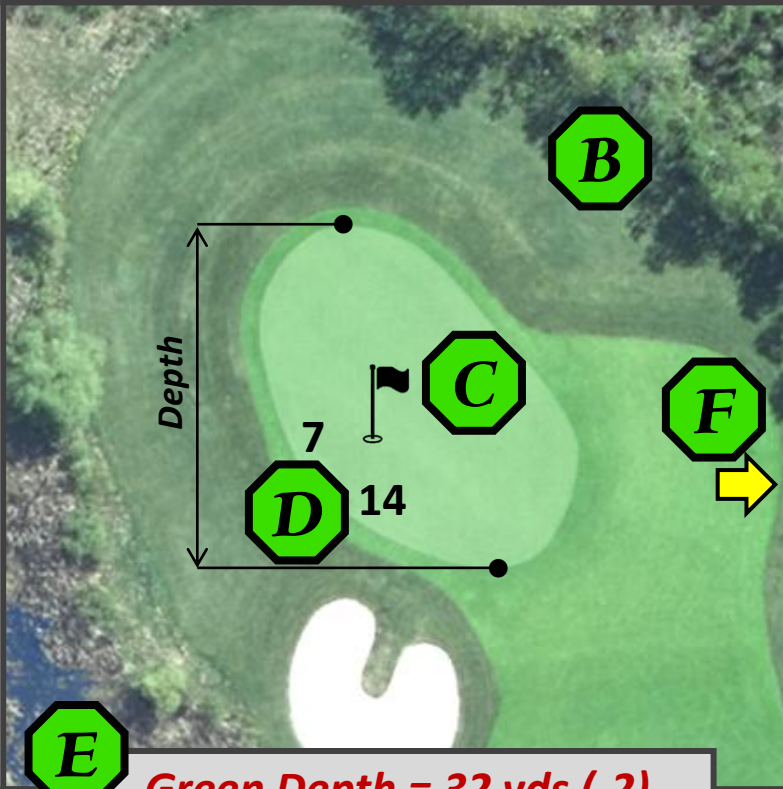
**NO PLAY ZONES:** Areas that are ornamental garden beds, turf nurseries or decorative flowerbeds are No Play Zones that are to be treated as Ground Under Repair. Player must proceed under Rule 16.1f.

5. **WASTE AREAS:** The large areas of sand on the right side of #1, in front of #7 tee and between #10 and #18 are waste areas. These areas are part of the general area. All other areas of sand are bunkers.

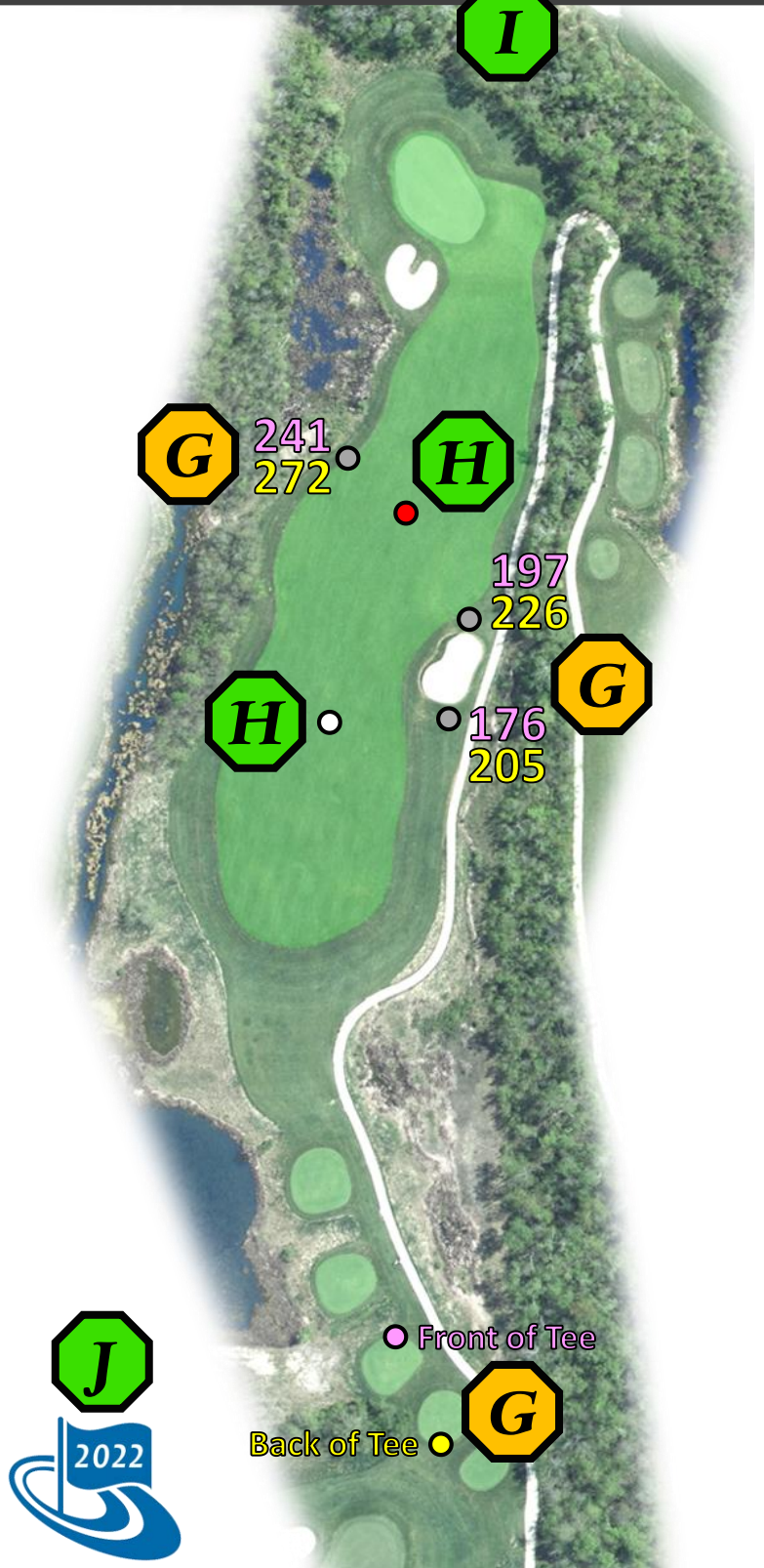
## Hole #6 (Par 4)

**Green Depth = 32 yds (-2)**

- A. This box provides pro tips and general information about the hole.
- B. Image of the green complex (aligned to the 150-yard marker).
- C. Flag showing the pin location.
- D. Distances from the front and side of the green to the pin location.
- E. Green depth and a +/- distance from the centre of the green to the pin in brackets.
- F. Arrow indicating the direction to the next tee (leave your clubs here when walking).
- G. Distances from spots in the teeing ground to various locations in the landing area. The distance text is colour coded to match the teeing ground spots. The actual tee marker positions will vary, but differences can be quickly paced off or estimated.
- H. Standard 100 ●, 150 ○, 200 ●, and 250 ● yard markers.



- I. Hole yardages for each flight.
- J. Flag indicating the year of photography.

## HOLE #1 (PAR 4)

**Green Depth = 35 yds (-8)**

***A short downhill dogleg right Par 4 starts your round at Baxter Creek. Hit your tee shot just past and to the right of the 150-yard marker to set yourself up with an easy approach shot.***

## HOLE #2 (PAR 4)

**Green Depth = 31 yds (+12)**

***You will want to favour the right side of this fairway off the tee to avoid the water on the left. Be sure of the yardage of your approach, as the greenside bunkers can be deceiving.***

## HOLE #3 (PAR 5)

**Green Depth = 32 yds (-2)**

***The 3rd at Baxter Creek is a long, straight Par 5. Favour the right side as O.B. runs down the entire left side of the hole. If you've hit a great drive, go for this green in two as it is relatively open to run your approach up to the green***

## HOLE #4 (PAR 3)

**Green Depth = 29 yds (-7)**

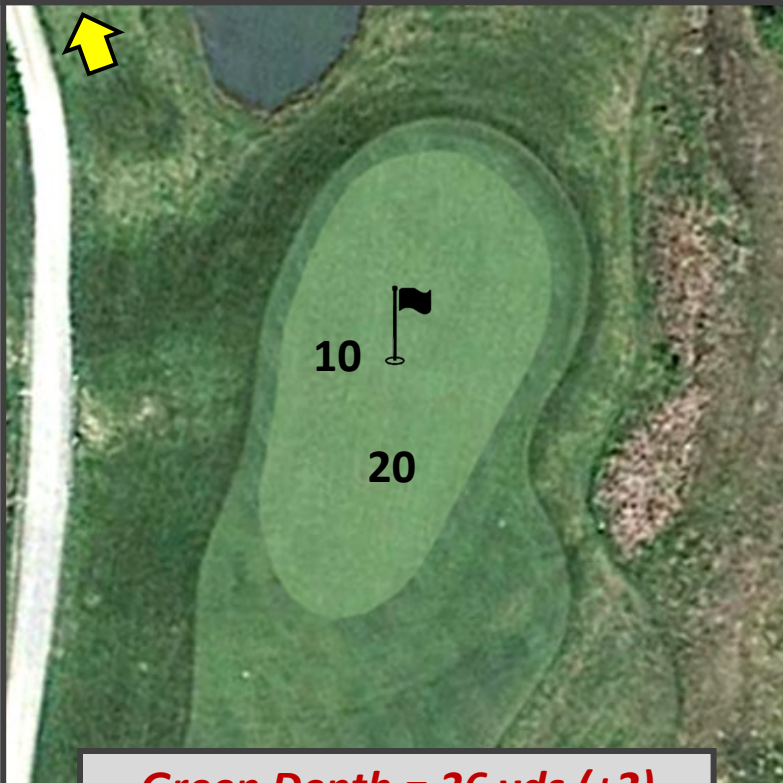
***This straight uphill Par 3 is the shortest on the course. You may need an extra club off the tee. Any shot missing the green will find the bottom of one of the many collection areas around this green.***





## HOLE #5 (PAR 4)

**Green Depth = 36 yds (+2)**

**#5 is a demanding downhill dogleg right Par 4. Hit your tee shot just left or over the top of the big tree. Avoid the water surrounding the back and right side of this long and narrow green.**

**Green Depth = 40 yds (-4)**

***A dogleg right Par 4 awaits you at the 6th tee. Hit your tee shot towards the 150-yard marker, leaving an uphill approach to a very deep green. Be sure to hit an extra club on your approach shot.***

## HOLE #7 (PAR 4)

**Green Depth = 37 yds (+12)**

**#7 is a dogleg left Par 4. Hit your tee shot towards the 150-yard marker, favouring the right side of the fairway to avoid being blocked out on your approach. Favour the left side on your approach to this two-tiered green and avoid the bunker.**

**Green Depth = 25 yds (-7)**

***#8 is a challenging Par 3 with a shallow green. It's better to be a little long of this green if you do miss. Double-check the wind before you hit your tee shot.***

## HOLE #9 (PAR 5)

**Green Depth = 32 yds (+13)**

**#9 is another long Par 5. Avoid the left bunkers with your tee shot to make the 2nd shot easier as you will want to get to the top of the hill if possible. The green is in line with the Canadian Flag!**

## HOLE #10 (PAR 4)

CH	A	B	ONS	C	R

**Green Depth = 36 yds (0)**

**#10 is another short dogleg left Par 4. Hit your tee shot just short of the fairway bunker to leave yourself a wedge into the green. Or grip it and rip it over the bunker and leave a short chip or maybe even a putt for an eagle!**





## HOLE #11 (PAR 4)

CH	A	B	ONS	C	R

**Green Depth = 28 yds (+7)**

***This straight Par 4 requires an accurate shot to find the narrow fairway. Aiming for the centre of the green on your approach should leave you with a decent chance for a birdie with any pin location.***

## HOLE #12 (PAR 3)

**Green Depth = 21 yds (-5)**

***#12 is not a long Par 3, but it's essential to hit this elevated green. Anything just missing the green will kick hard off the banks, leaving a difficult up and down.***

## HOLE #13 (PAR 5)

**Green Depth = 31 yds (+13)**

**#13 is a long and demanding Par 5. Favour the right side of the fairway off the tee. Hit your 2nd towards the 150-yard marker again, favouring the right side to prevent being blocked out on your 3rd into this very flat green.**

**Green Depth = 26 yds (-7)**

***Another dogleg Par 4 to the right. Hit your tee shot towards the 150-yard marker and be sure to avoid the O.B. down the left side. Be sure of your approach, as this green runs away from the player.***

## HOLE #15 (PAR 4)

CH	A	B	ONS	C	R

**Green Depth = 22 yds (-4)**

***Hit it straight up the middle to avoid the trees on both sides. (I've been trying to hit it straight all day!)  
Be sure of your yardage on your approach as the green is shallow.***

## HOLE #16 (PAR 3)

**Green Depth = 25 yds (-3)**

**#16 is a long and difficult Par 3. Take enough club to get to the green comfortably, and if you are going to miss, be sure you miss left.**





## HOLE #17 (PAR 5)

CH	A	B	ONS	C	R

**Green Depth = 23 yds (+1)**

**#17 is a short but narrow and tricky Par 5. Favour the right off the tee to avoid the water. Layup just past the 150-yard marker or short of the bunker in the middle of the fairway if you can get it there. Long hitters can get to this green in two, but it's all carry.**





## HOLE #18 (PAR 4)

CH	A	B	ONS	C	R
345	345	333	333	333	333



**Green Depth = 26 yds (+11)**

***Hit your tee shot straight towards the 150-yard marker, the silo is not the target. Be sure to take enough club on your approach to carry the huge greenside bunker short right.***

***Will congratulations be in order after your final putt?***
