### NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

This information supplements the 2023 Local Rules and Terms of Conditions for the GTA AM Tour. The current issue of the Golf Canada Rules of Golf govern play. **Any rules on the host club scorecard do not apply. Penalty for breach of a Local Rule is the general penalty, unless otherwise noted.**

1. **OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 18.2):** Defined by the line between the course-side points at ground level of white lines, dots or stakes and fence posts defining out of bounds. A ball is out of bounds when it is beyond any wall defining the boundary of the course. A ball coming to rest on or beyond a road defined as Out of Bounds is Out of Bounds, even though it may lie on another part of the Course that is in bounds for other holes.
2. **HOST CLUB DROP ZONES ARE NOT AVAILABLE:** Any Drop Zone available at this event will be indicated by a GTA AM Tour sign.
3. **PENALTY AREAS (Rule 17):** Red and yellow lines define the edge of the penalty area. Where penalty areas are not marked with lines, the change in the height of the grass defines the edge of the penalty area. Where there is no change in the height of the grass, the penalty area is defined by its natural boundaries. Unmarked penalty areas are red penalty areas.

**HOLE #10:** The creek is defined as a **Red Penalty Area** and NOT a Yellow Penalty Area.

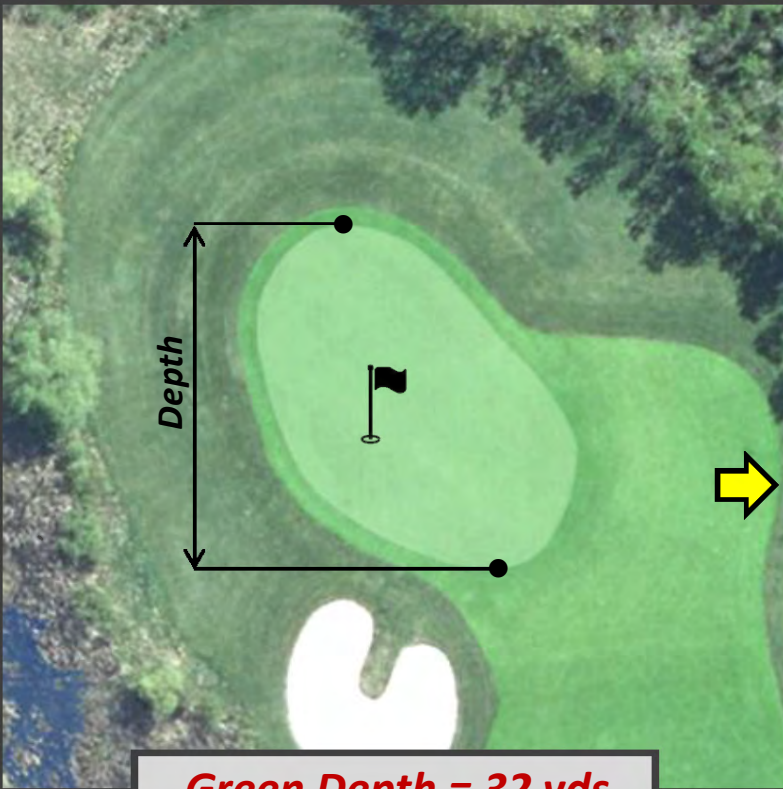
4. **OBSTRUCTIONS AND GROUND UNDER REPAIR (Rule 16.1 applies):** Any areas of ground under repair will be marked or noted.

**NO PLAY ZONES:** Areas that are ornamental garden beds, turf nurseries or decorative flowerbeds are No Play Zones that are to be treated as Ground Under Repair. Player must proceed under Rule 16.1f.

# How To Use This Guide

**Green Depth = 32 yds**

On the left side of the page, you will see the hole number and par. The square image shows the green complex (aligned to the 150-yard marker) with the pin location for the event.

The green depth is also shown. A yellow arrow indicates the direction to the next tee (leave your clubs here when walking).

This box provides pro tips and general information about the hole.

On the right side, the yardages for each flight are shown. The hole image indicates distances from spots in the teeing ground ●●● to various locations in the landing area ●. The distance text is colour coded to match the teeing ground spots. The actual tee marker positions will vary, but differences can be quickly paced off or estimated. Standard 100 ●, 150 ○, 200 ●, and 250 ● yard markers may also be shown.

**Green Depth = 36 yds**

*A relatively short Par 5 starting hole, but don't let the shorter length fool you. Your game will be challenged early on the first hole. Hit your tee shot left centre of the fairway. Lay up your second shot to the 100-yard marker to avoid all the trouble surrounding the green. Play this one smart, and you may start your day off with a Birdie or maybe something a little better!*

**Green Depth = 33 yds**

**How did your first hole go? Well, it's time to settle into your round and focus on the task at hand. A tee shot that finds the right centre of the fairway is ideal for your approach to this green. The green is divided in the center with a ridge, so club selection is essential. Choose your approach club wisely if the pin is at the back.**

**Green Depth = 33 yds**

***Moving along to a great Par 3 that will grab your attention quickly. The green is well protected with water and sand to the right and trees to the left. This hole usually plays downhill and is slightly shorter than the yardage. Par is a good score on this challenging hole, but Birdies await those that can shoot darts!***

**Green Depth = 34 yds**

*A long narrow hole that demands your full respect. Your tee shot needs to be straight on this long Par 5 to make a par or better. The fairway narrows as you get closer to the green, so sharpen your focus and use caution in selecting a club for your second shot. A Birdie here is a good score, but then again, so is a Par.*

**Green Depth = 34 yds**

*To have a straightforward approach to the green, your tee shot needs to get past the tall tree on the left corner of the dogleg. A fairway wood or a long iron is all that is required off the tee for a short approach to the green. Dial in your yardage and hit your number as the green is protected front right and long left with bunkers.*

**Green Depth = 23 yds**

*Back to back dog leg lefts are the righty drawers or lefty faders dream. To have the best angle into the green, hit your tee shot down the right side of this hole but beware of the fairway bunker guarding your ideal tee shot. This green is well protected, and an approach to the right side of the green is wise, regardless of where Christian decided to place the flag.*

**Green Depth = 30 yds**

*Now it's time for the straight shooters to shine! This #1 Handicap long Par 4 demands an accurate drive avoiding bunkers left and right. A tee shot that finds the fairway will still have a long approach into the green bunkered in the front. Out of Bounds taunts you down the right side.*

**Green Depth = 32 yds**

*After navigating the most challenging hole on the course, the 17<sup>th</sup> ranked handicap hole should be a welcomed break. Avoid the bunkers in the front of the green, and you should have a good chance at par or birdie. This hole plays downwind and is slightly shorter than the posted yardage. A rare hole where the entire field can compare themselves to every flight!*

**Green Depth = 33 yds**

*This is a great finishing hole on this challenging front nine. A well-hit tee shot to the 150-yard marker gives you a good look at this elevated and well-bunkered green. To finish the front nine strong, be careful with your club selection to put it close on this wide but not very deep green.*

**Green Depth = 38 yds**

*Making the turn towards the back nine requires a strategic tee shot as your ball drops into the valley below. If you carry the creek from the tee, you will have the best approach to the green. Take dead aim with your tee shot and swing free, as anything short of the creek will leave a blind or semi-blind shot to the green.*

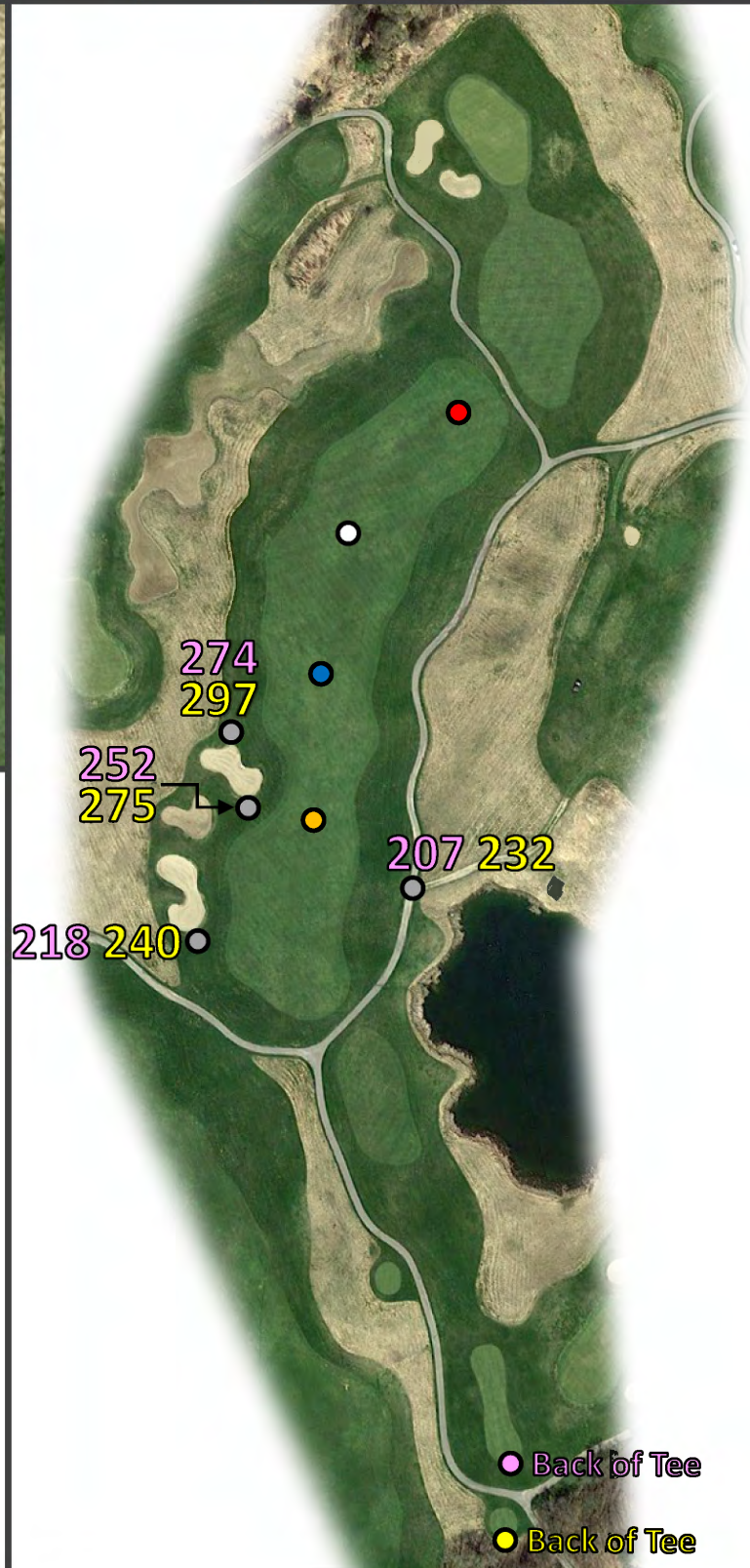
## Hole #11 (Par 5)

**Green Depth = 34 yds**

*Another reachable but well-protected Par 5. Your target off the tee should be the last bunker on the left side of the fairway. If going for it in two is your style, make sure that your second shot is played far enough to the right as the waste area to the left comes into play if you aim for the green. A layup past the 100- yard marker gives you the best angle for a simple pitch.*

**Green Depth = 36 yds**

*When playing this Par 3, carefully choosing your club is important due to the large green. Be mindful of the waste area on the left and fescue on the right, as any tee shots that miss the mark could be lost. However, with some luck, you could also score an Ace today!*

**Green Depth = 35 yds**

*This is a long Par 4, but it plays downhill and downwind, so let the big dog eat! The best position off the tee is the left centre of the fairway. If you miss the green to the right on your approach, your ball will likely find one of three deep bunkers. Ensure your strategy avoids them at all costs or one of the most difficult up and downs will await.*

**Green Depth = 33 yds**

*The last of Timber Ridge's excellent Par 5's dog legs twice before the green. Start your tee shot toward the bunkers with a left-to-right shape to find the ideal position in the fairway. From there, either lay up with a short iron to the 100-yard marker or go for the green with a long iron or fairway wood.*

## Hole #16 (Par 4)

**Green Depth = 42 yds**

*Rated the #2 handicap hole and the hardest on the back nine, accuracy and a dead straight drive are a must on this hole. Trees guard both sides of the fairway. Club selection is vital to get close to the flag on another enormous and undulating green. Par is a good score on this hole and could gain you a stroke on the field.*

**Green Depth = 38 yds**

*As you head towards the last of the Par 3 holes, you'll find the beautiful and arguably what could be their signature hole here at Timber Ridge, which drops about 75 feet from tee to green. A long narrow green is your target. Use one or two clubs less as the hole plays shorter due to the significant elevation change.*

## Hole #18 (Par 4)

**Green Depth = 22 yds**

*The closing hole requires a precise tee shot to navigate the many bunkers well placed to eat up any errant tee shots. An ideal position for your tee shot is just short of the bunkers in the middle of the fairway. This will leave a short to mid-iron into this wide but shallow green. This green is elevated and bunkered in front. Give yourself enough club to get onto the green.*



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
