### **NOTICE TO COMPETITORS**

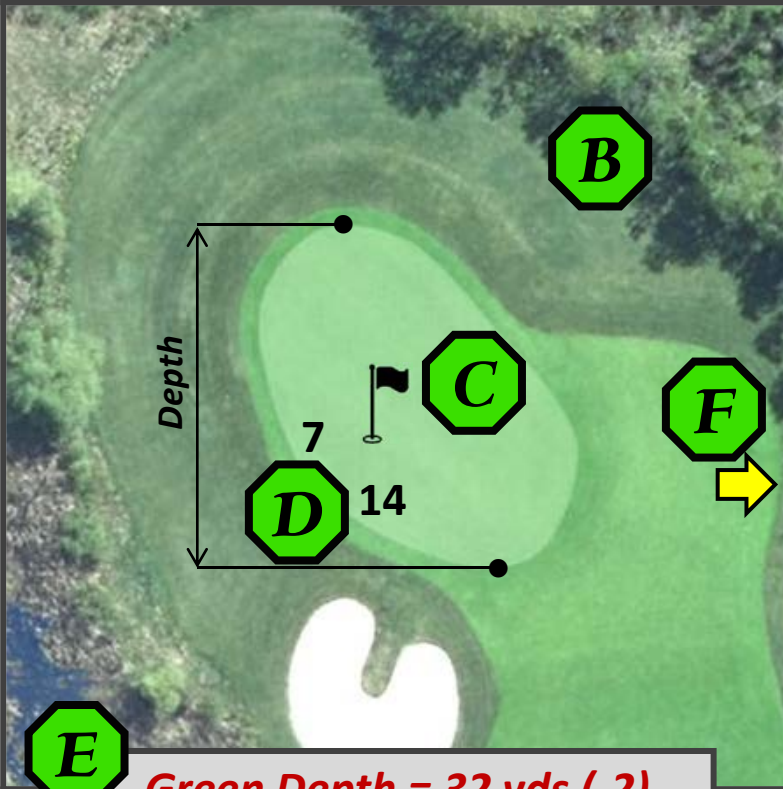
This information supplements the 2025 Local Rules and Terms of Conditions for the GTA AM Tour. The current issue of the Golf Canada Rules of Golf govern play. **Any rules on the host club scorecard do not apply. Penalty for breach of a Local Rule is the general penalty, unless otherwise noted.**

1. **OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 18.2):** See GTA AM Tour Hard Card for how Out of Bounds is defined.  
**HOLE #1:** The range on the left side is out of bounds and is defined by white stakes.  
**HOLE #15:** The sidewalk and road behind #15 green is out of bounds and is defined by white dots or white stakes.
2. **HOST CLUB DROP ZONES ARE NOT AVAILABLE:** Any Drop Zone available at this event will be indicated by a GTA AM Tour sign.
3. **PENALTY AREAS (Rule 17):** Red and yellow lines define the edge of the penalty area. Where penalty areas are not marked with lines, the change in the height of the grass defines the edge of the penalty area. Where there is no change in the height of the grass, the penalty area is defined by its natural boundaries. Unmarked penalty areas are red penalty areas.
4. **OBSTRUCTIONS AND GROUND UNDER REPAIR (Rule 16.1 applies):** Any areas of ground under repair will be marked or noted.  
**NO PLAY ZONES:** Areas that are ornamental garden beds, turf nurseries or decorative flowerbeds are No Play Zones that are to be treated as Ground Under Repair. Players must proceed under Rule 16.1f.

- A. This box provides pro tips and general information about the hole.
- B. Image of the green complex (aligned to the 150-yard marker).
- C. Flag showing the pin location.
- D. Distances from the front and side of the green to the pin location.
- E. Green depth and a +/- distance from the centre of the green to the pin in brackets.
- F. Arrow indicating the direction to the next tee (leave your clubs here when walking).
- G. Distances from spots in the teeing ground ● ● ● to various locations in the landing area ○. The distance text is colour coded to match the teeing ground spots. The actual tee marker positions will vary, but differences can be quickly paced off or estimated.
- H. Standard 100 ●, 150 ○, 200 ●, and 250 ● yard markers.

**Green Depth = 25 yds (-7)**

*The gentle dogleg rewards tee shots hit to the left of center with the best angle for your approach. Favour the right side of the green as the slope and contours around the putting surface can be severe and errant shots often find their way into the pond that guards the front and left.*

**Green Depth = 25 yds (+3)**

*Out of bounds left off the tee can be a threat, but there's room to the right. The last 30 yards to the green is uphill, and approach shots must carry the entire way, making getting home in two difficult. Better to lay up around the 100-yard marker and favour the left side of the green with your short iron.*

**Green Depth = 30 yds (-8)**

*A bunker protects the front right of the green and since this hole generally plays into the prevailing winds an extra club is often called for. The green is pitched nicely to the right and a well struck shot just to the left of centre can result in an excellent birdie try.*

**Green Depth = 26 yds (26)**

*A reachable par 5 on the right day, but the landing area is squeezed by a pond on the left about 230 yards off the tee, so distance and accuracy are key. Ideal second shots clear the incline just short of the 150-yard marker and avoid the water left. Approach shots that go beyond the pin result in very difficult and slippery fast putts.*

**Green Depth = 35 yds (-13)**

*Following the natural terrain, this hole leans a little to the left off the tee; therefore, the ideal aiming point is the bunker on the right-hand side of the fairway. The green is quite deep, and flag placement needs to be factored into your club selection.*

**Green Depth = 22 yds (+3)**

*As one of our signature hole candidates, some century-old elm trees frame this beautiful par 3. The downhill tee shot requires distance and accuracy, avoiding bunkers on both sides. Chipping from the front of the green is a better option than long.*

**Green Depth = 24 yds (-7)**

*This modest length par 4 is best played with a conservative shot off the tee to a level landing area, leaving the easiest approach to a well-bunkered and rolling green.*

*Play it aggressively or play it smart, and either strategy could put a circle on your scorecard.*

**Green Depth = 27 yds (+1)**

*Although the flags at Sleepy Hollow are usually colour-coded, matching the hole locations, today with the GTA AM Tour flags, you need to pay close attention to the pin sheet at number 8, as pin placements may mean as much as 2 clubs from the front to the back of this 27-yard deep green.*

**Green Depth = 20 yds (-2)**

*Rounding out the front nine is a reachable par 5, but the blind uphill second shot must run through a narrow opening to this small, well-protected green. When laying up, try to avoid leaving a 70-yard approach as some of the downhill lies at this distance present an additional challenge.*

**Green Depth = 32 yds (-3)**

*Clear the hill with your tee shot and you'll have a mid to long iron home. Average length tee shots tend to finish in the rough dotted by pine tree groupings.*

*Short of the green is a small pond, which you need to be aware of if you choose to lay up. Easily one of the most interesting and well-guarded greens on the course.*

**Green Depth = 32 yds (-2)**

*Playing as the #2 handicap hole, success here requires your tee shot to split the fairway as ponds come into play on both sides off the tee, while second shots require precision to find level ground on this plateau-style fairway. There are very few flat lies on this hole.*

**Green Depth = 33 yds (+9)**

*Grass bunkers bordering the left rough and a stand of trees just beyond are best avoided by a tee shot in the centre or slightly right. Another one of those long greens where the flag position is important. The green is deceptively quick from the back and surrounded by bunkers.*

**Green Depth = 29 yds (-3)**

*A great risk/reward par 4 where a tee shot of no less than 250 yards carry is required to clear the pond and the bunker guarding the green, leaving a potential eagle try. The other approach is a mid-iron off the tee with an inviting downhill second shot to a large putting surface. The green looks fairly level, but breaks can be severe.*

**Green Depth = 28 yds (+4)**

*A double-tiered green guarded by bunkers left, right and center provides a little more challenge than you might expect with a hole of this length. Out of bounds right and long need to factor into your club selection as well. Be thankful that today, the front right pin placement is not in play, as it can be very difficult.*

**Green Depth = 33 yds (-1)**

*This hole rewards only the best of shots, requiring distance, control and accuracy. Longer hitters will find the left side of the fairway preferable off the tee. The kidney-shaped green features a large pond and two bunkers on the front left, with out-of-bounds just over the back. These challenges have earned number 16 respect in the discussion of the signature hole at Sleepy Hollow.*

*Our very own "valley of sin" gathers most shots just short and to the right, so take lots of club and aim for the back portion of the green.*

*By this time, you'll be familiar with the rolling fairways, a distinct feature of our layout. Tee shots aimed at the large willow will provide the best result. This elevated and well-trapped green has some sharp contours and can be deceptively quick, so study this one because nobody wants to end his or her round with a three-putt!*
