NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

This information supplements the 2026 Local Rules and Terms of Conditions for the GTA AM Tour. The current issue of the Golf Canada Rules of Golf govern play. **Any rules on the host club scorecard do not apply. Penalty for breach of a Local Rule is the general penalty, unless otherwise noted.**

1. **OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 18.2):** See GTA AM Tour Hard Card for how Out of Bounds is defined.
2. **HOST CLUB DROP ZONES ARE NOT AVAILABLE:** Any Drop Zone available at this event will be indicated by a GTA AM Tour sign.
3. **PENALTY AREAS (Rule 17):** Red and yellow lines define the edge of the penalty area. Where penalty areas are not marked with lines, the change in the height of the grass defines the edge of the penalty area. Where there is no change in the height of the grass, the penalty area is defined by its natural boundaries. Unmarked penalty areas are red penalty areas.

All areas of long grass, including the forested areas, are red penalty area No Play Zones (Rule 17.1e). The player must take penalty relief under Rule 17.1d by adding one penalty stroke. Players are not permitted to enter areas of long grass or forest.

No play zones for each hole extend to infinity. Players must NOT play their ball from another fairway.

For a ball in the General Area where the player has interference from a No Play Zone with their stance or swing, the player MUST take free relief (Rule 16.1f) by finding the nearest point of complete relief, no nearer to the hole and establish a relief area of one club-length.

DROP ZONES AVAILABLE:

HOLE #4:

Any player whose ball comes to rest behind the green and in the long grass on Hole #4 must, under penalty of one stroke:

- Take relief under Rule 17.1, or
- As an extra relief option, drop the original ball or another ball in the dropping zone.

4. **ENVIRONMENTALLY SENSITIVE AREAS:** PLAYERS ARE NOT PERMITTED TO ENTER AREAS OF LONG GRASS OR FOREST.

Penalty: Breach of Code of Conduct and may result in Disqualification.

5. **OBSTRUCTIONS AND GROUND UNDER REPAIR (Rule 16.1 applies):** Any areas of ground under repair will be marked or noted.

NO PLAY ZONES: Areas that are ornamental garden beds, turf nurseries or decorative flowerbeds are No Play Zones that are to be treated as Ground Under Repair. Players must proceed under Rule 16.1f.

How To Use This Guide



Green Depth = 38 yds (+5)

The image above shows a photograph of the hole. Also shown is the green depth and a +/- distance from the centre of the green to the pin in brackets (measured straight, from the centre of the fairway, at the 150-yard marker). Note: your specific angle of approach will determine the actual green depth along your line of play and may be different than indicated.

This box provides pro tips and general information about the hole.

The hole sketch on the right indicates distances from various sprinkler heads to the centre of the green as well as various other distances from point to point.

The chart below shows the event yardages for the hole for each flight.

The Nest- Hole #1 (Par 4)



Green Depth = 39 yds (+0)

The opening hole is a short Par 4 with an inviting fairway to ease yourself into the round. Going for the green with a front pin may be tempting, but anything less than a perfect shot will find a deep bunker fronting the green.

The ideal play is right of the fairway bunker, leaving just a lob wedge into a green sloped severely back to front with a ridge bisecting the green. 2 putt is no bargain on this hole!

The Nest- Hole #2 (Par 3)



Green Depth = 38 yds (+0)

The 2nd hole is the shortest hole on the course. Stretching out to just 145 yards, this short Par 3 still brings plenty of trouble to the table, and hitting the green is the key to success. This is the highest point on the property, so check the wind before choosing your club! Missing left means a chip from far below the green. Missing right means a chip running away from you, but there is more room to save your par. Find the green and call it a day!

The Nest- Hole #3 (Par 4)



Green Depth = 36 yds (+0)

The 3rd hole is a medium-length Par 4 with a speed slot past the bunkers that will shorten this hole dramatically. With a little more room to the right that meets the eye, the ideal line is right centre, as all balls will funnel to the left. If you don't find the speed slot, the approach plays 10 yards less than what you measure. The green is relatively flat, but has subtle breaks, so make sure to commit to your putt if you want a birdie!

The Nest- Hole #4 (Par 4)



Green Depth = 30 yds (+0)

The 4th hole is a short Par 4 with no bunkers to catch an errant shot. The key to this hole is staying left to reach the upper fairway. This will leave a flat lie with a great look at the green. Leaking the ball too far right could leave a blind shot to an elevated green. The green has an upper and lower level, so find the right section if you want a good chance at Birdie!

The Nest- Hole #5 (Par 4)



Green Depth = 38 yds (+0)

The 5th hole is a straight-away medium-length Par 4 that can play much shorter or longer depending on wind direction. The fairway bunker is not in play off the tee, except for the longest hitters. The ideal play is to leave yourself on the plateau 125 yards from the green. The green has a ridge bisecting it, so don't miss long, or face a difficult 2 putt.

The Nest- Hole #6 (Par 5)



Green Depth = 40 yds (+0)

The 6th hole is the 1st of back-to-back Par 5's. Playing uphill toward the clubhouse, this is a 3 shot hole for most; however, long hitters can still reach this green.

If you lay up, make sure to stay short of the bunkers 60 yards from the green. There is room both left and right of the green, but left is better than right. If the pin is back right above the ridge, you could find yourself with a difficult putt!

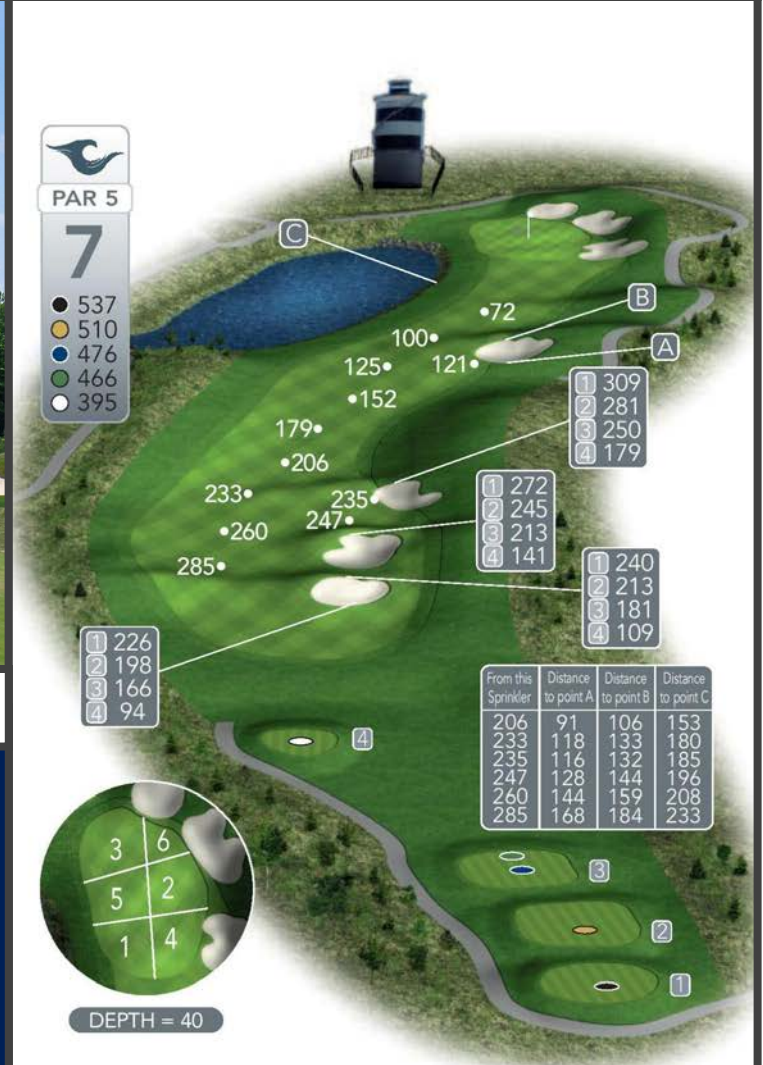


The Nest- Hole #7 (Par 5)



Green Depth = 40 yds (+0)

The 7th Hole is the 2nd straight Par 5 that offers a chance at birdie or eagle (or even an albatross like we saw in 2021). The fairway bunkers look far away but can be carried with a good tee shot. The fairway slopes left to right and downhill, so aim down the left and let the slope add some yardage. Stay right on the approach, or a poorly struck shot might find the water. The green is guarded by sand to the right, but the large green allows the chance to save your par!

The Nest- Hole #8 (Par 3)

The 8th hole is the 2nd hole without a bunker. This long Par 3 could play even longer into the wind, so check your yardage on the tee. The obvious play is to avoid the water and stay left; however, balls will usually stay on the slope left of the green with an adept touch required to save par. The green is relatively flat, so find the green and expect an easy par or possible birdie!

The Nest- Hole #9 (Par 4)



Green Depth = 34 yds (+0)

The final hole on the outward nine is a long Par 4 playing slightly uphill. The bunkers seem ominous from the tee but are very playable. Missing right is utterly dead with a large tree imposing on your tee shot. The fairway slopes left to right, so aim at the 2nd bunker and let the fairway work to your advantage. There is plenty of room right and left of this green, so make sure not to short side yourself on the approach.

The Nest- Hole #10 (Par 4)

This short Par 4 is reminiscent of the 1st hole, where long hitters are tempted to hit driver, but this is not the best option.

The green is protected by a large swale in front you cannot see, so running the ball onto the green is impossible. Play to the 100-yard marker and wedge it on for your best chance at circling your score on the next tee!

The Nest- Hole #11 (Par 5)



Green Depth = 38 yds (+0)

The first Par 5 on the back nine is a slight dogleg left with a huge speed slot just past the two fairway bunkers. Longer hitters can split the bunkers and find themselves with only 200 yards for their second, making this a birdie hole. If you're like most of us, lay short of the right bunker and layup short of the 2nd bunker for a wedge shot to a green sloping back to front. Missing on the hill to the left will make an up and down difficult.

The Nest- Hole #12 (Par 3)



Green Depth = 37 yds (+0)

The 12th hole is a long Par 3 where Carrick's visual deception is at its finest. The hole looks 1-2 clubs downhill, but it is actually level and plays the indicated yardage. The green is angled and slopes front to back, so a miss left is safer if you need to bail out. The green has some subtle challenges, so make sure to read your putts from both sides to avoid a 3-putt.

The Nest- Hole #13 (Par 4)

The 13th hole is another short Par 4 where the longer hitter is tempted to go for the green. Unlike #1 and #10, this hole is worth the risk for longer hitters. Let the big dog eat and either putt for eagle or pitch it close for a tap-in birdie. The green is flat compared to most greens, so don't expect a skin unless you can make that elusive eagle.

The Nest- Hole #14 (Par 5)



Green Depth = 36 yds (+0)

The 14th hole is another reachable Par 5 for the long hitters; however, avoiding the fairway bunkers is key, especially the right bunker. The fairway slopes right to left, so the left bunkers are popular. If you don't have the horsepower, lay up to 85 yards for a flat lie and good look at the pin. The green is bisected by a ridge into two tiers. If the pin is in the front, pitching from left or short right is doable to save your Par.

The Nest- Hole #15 (Par 4)

The 15th is a straightaway Par 4 that usually plays long. Avoid the deep bunkers off the tee or face a forced layup to the green. The ideal line is down the right side, and anything leaking right should stay in play due to the large slope. The green is large and slopes back to front, so expect many 3-putts here if you don't hit it close. This is a tough hole, so Par is a good score!

The Nest- Hole #16 (Par 4)

Your round ends with a 3-hole stretch cut into dense forest. The 16th has one of the more undulating fairways, so aim at the white birch tree and hope for a flat lie. The green is protected by bunkers left and right with a lower tier in the back left, so if you miss long to a middle or front pin, expect a difficult 2-putt to save your Par.

This par 3 is protected by tall trees, making the wind difficult to assess. The green looks flat from the tee, but does slope slightly from right to left. Several subtle undulations could make a difference in going low late in your round.

The Nest- Hole #18 (Par 4)



Green Depth = 34 yds (+0)

The 18th is a lengthy and challenging Par 4 that plays more uphill than it appears. Avoid the right bunker and aim down the left centre for the best angle to this green. The green is open just right of the green, so if the wind is blowing, you may not feel it in the fairway. Long left of this green will surely find the penalty area, so a bailout short right is the proper miss. If you're putting toward the clubhouse, the putt is much slower than you would think.
